The Professional Standards Unit is pleased to announce the launch of the updated Safeguarding Children and Young People Framework for the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne. The revised framework replaces the CAM Child Safety Policy and the May Our Children Flourish – Code of Conduct for Caring for Children. The new policy reflects recent changes to legislation arising from:

- Victorian Child Safe Standards (Commission for Children and Young People)
- Reportable Conduct Scheme (Commission for Children and Young People)
- National Catholic Safeguarding Standards (Catholic Professional Standards Limited)
- National Principles for Child Safe Organisations (Australian Human Rights Commission).

Members of our Child Safety Committee will be attending the Geelong session for those involved in the implementation of child safety policies and procedures.
