Pastoral Note:

- For pastoral reasons, the texts of the Pentecost Vigil need not be used at a Saturday evening Mass to celebrate the feast, However, encouragement should be given to the prolonged celebration of Mass in the form of a Vigil, whose character is not baptismal as in the Easter Vigil, but is one of urgent prayer after the example of the Apostles and disciples who preserved together in prayer with Mary the Mother of Jesus as they awaited the Holy Spirit.
- Pentecost Sunday is the last day of the Easter Season. The Easter candle is now given a place of honour in the baptistery.
