Food for Thought & The Spirit:

HOLY COMMUNION: The more complete form of participation in the Mass by which the faithful... receive the Lord's body from the same sacrifice is strongly endorsed

Vatican II, SC 55

It is most desirable that the faithful... receive the Lord's Body from hosts consecrated at the same Mass and that, in the cases where this is foreseen, they partake of the chalice so that, even by means of the signs, communion may stand out more clearly as a participation in the sacrifice actually being celebrated.
