This Sunday marks National Sorry Day, when we remember and mark our country's troubled history with First Nations peoples. It is the start of National Reconciliation Week. The theme of the week this year is **'Grounded in truth – Walk together with courage'**. (It)... calls for a comprehensive process of truth-telling about Australia's colonial history – understanding the past so that we can build a future together. In the Gospel reading this week, Jesus tells his disciples, 'If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him and our home with him.' There's a challenge there for Jesus' followers, to turn their love for Christ into action to keep Christ's message alive in the world. Reconciliation Week is a reminder that if we are to keep Christ's word – if we are to make a home with God – then we need to reach out with love to our First Nations peoples.
