## LITURGY IN OUR PARISH THIS WEEK

EMBER DAYS (from the German Quatember, 'quarter day' or, as the Irish used to day Quarter Tense) mark the beginning of each of the four seasons. Kept in the Roman Church since the fifth century, they are observed in Australia on the first Fridays of Autumn and Spring (March and September) as special days of prayer and penance.

On Rogation and Ember days the Church is accustomed to entreat the Lord for the various needs of humanity, especially for the fruits of the earth and for human labour, and to give GŇLYC 45 thanks to him publicly.
