For if their rejection means the reconci-liation of the world, what will their acceptance mean but life from the dead? For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable. Just as you were once disobedient to God but now have received mercy because of their disobedience, so they have now been disobedient in order that by the mercy shown to you they also may receive mercy. For God has consigned all men to disobedience, that he may have mercy upon all. This is the Word of the Lord.

THE ONLY GOD IS A UNIVERSAL GOD: Sometimes we may think that the God we believe in is our God only and that His Kingdom is only ours. Today's texts are affirming the universality of God and of his kingdom. The Canaanite woman in today's Gospel represents the foreigners who accept the faith in the one God. Jesus grants her request based on her faith in Him, not on being a gentile, a woman or a foreigner: "Woman, you have great faith, Let your wish be granted".
