Again I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything they ask, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them." **Gospel of the Lord.**

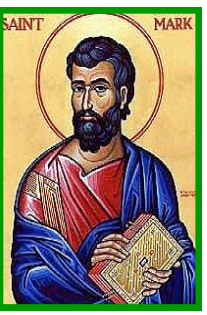

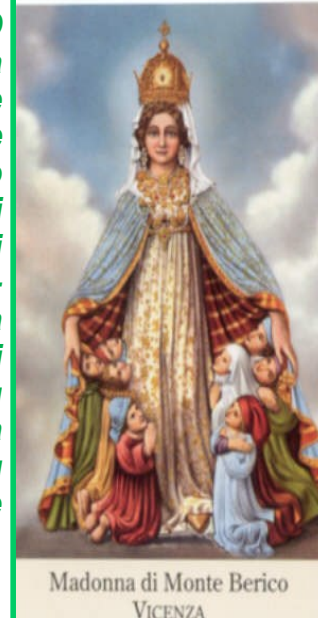
Celebrazioni in onore della Madonna Di Monte Berico

FRATERNAL CORRECTION: There are different ways to express fraternal charity. Fraternal correction is one of them. It is an act of love and mercy. It is also a very difficult precept to follow because no one is perfect. Practicing fraternal correction is a Gospel value based on true love. It is to be exercised for the purpose of helping another person who is my brother and sister whom I love. In doing so we are called to hate evil but to love the sinner walking with him/her on the path of conversion. We all know by experience that it is extremely easy to perceive the faults of others. When we do, we would do well to examine ourselves and not only to see if we have the moral authority to correct and also to see whether we are acting out of mercy and love or if there is something else like pride. We are undoubtedly dealing with a delicate matter reminding us that as a community we are also responsible for one another. The Gospel tells us that prayer is paramount as we exercise fraternal correction. There is also a methodology in practicing it: first in private with the person, second with two or three witnesses, and lastly the community. We pray that we may be humble sin seeking holiness together, helping one another mindful of the words of St. Paul in today's second reading: "Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law". May we correct each other as an act of charity.



CORREZIONE FRATERNA: In tanti modi si esprime la carità fraterna. La correzione fraterna è una forma di carità particolarmente difficile praticarla. Richiede innanzitutto vero amore, squisita sensibilità, tatto e delicatezza. La prudenza e la buona psicologia ci debbono essere di aiuto per non commettere errori e per sortire gli effetti sperati. La prima condizione però è la preghiera intensa e reiterata perché solo con la grazia divina riusciamo a raggiungere il cuore del nostro prossimo e guadagnarlo al bene e al Signore. L'umile invocazione dello Spirito ci consente di attingere la luce necessaria per formulare la nostra ammonizione nel modo migliore senza offendere, ma solo per guarire il fratello dal suo male. Talvolta, quando incontriamo resistenze e particolare durezza di cuore, dobbiamo coinvolgere altri fratelli in questa difficile opera: abbiamo bisogno della loro preghiera e della loro fattiva collaborazione. Per questo Gesù ci ricorda: «Se due di voi sopra la terra si accorderanno per domandare qualunque cosa, il Padre mio che è nei cieli ve la concederà. Perché dove sono due o tre riuniti nel mio nome, io sono in mezzo a loro». In alcuni casi, fortunatamente rari ai nostri giorni, deve essere inevitabilmente coinvolta la chiesa gerarchica affinché intervenga con il peso della grazia e dell'autorità di cui gode. È importante tener sempre presente che la correzione fraterna di cui parla il Signore e a cui ci Egli ci esorta deve essere sempre uno squisito atto di carità e di amore fraterno, mai un mero gesto di autorità e ancor meno solo di condanna.



SUPPLICA ALLA MADONNA DI MONTE BERICO

Origine della devozione alla Madonna di Monte Berico che si venera nella Chiesa di Santa Brigida in North Fitzroy Melbourne
Nei primi decenni del 1400 una pestilenza ostinata mieteva vittime nel Vicentino. Verso la metà del Marzo 1426 una donna di età avanzata, certa Vincenza Pasini, si recò dal Vescovo di Vicenza per raccontargli che, pochi giorni prima, il 7 Marzo, mentre si recava dal marito, che stava lavorando nella sua piccola vigna sul Monte Berico, nel luogo ove oggi sorge il Santuario, le era apparsa una donna bellissima che le aveva detto: "Non temere, Vincenza. Io sono Maria, la Madre di Cristo morto in Croce per la salvezza del genere umano".
