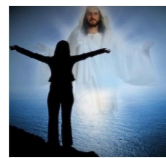

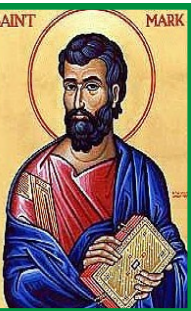

**God rejoices in forgiving**

The readings in today's liturgy all speak of mercy through forgiveness by God, and God finds reason to rejoice and celebrate when we, sinners, allows him to forgive us. Often times, we have been used to think that we, receivers of forgiveness and mercy, are the ones rejoicing because thus we are unburdened of our fear and anxiety caused by our standing against God's commandments and love. The thinking of the rebellious son who comes to his senses after an adventure of dissolute life is ours also: "Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you; I no longer deserve to be called your son; treat me as one of your paid servants". We find reason to rejoice knowing that God will not reject us as we go repentant to him. This is true, as we have often experienced new serenity and joy after forgiveness. But the parables of the lost sheep, the lost coin and the lost son give us a much more important revelation: the greater joy that gives reason for celebrating is on the one who found it and embraces back. God rejoices in forgiving. This reveals the pure love of God in manifesting his mercy to us. God's forgiveness and to have us back in his love is all that he wants, because God's forgiveness is not half-hearted and given grudgingly, but complete, absolute and given with a "banquet celebration". When we become aware of this, then we enter into the joyful spirit of God's mercy and wish we could experience it more and more. We have a constant reason for it because of our weaknesses, imperfections and sinful tendencies: "I rejoice in my weaknesses", says St. Paul, "because the grace of God is much the greater". (2 Cor. 12:9) The Saints were well aware of this and would seek constantly the mercy of God. We are in the Year of Mercy: let us give God a reason to rejoice as we seek his mercy and forgiveness. Today we celebrate our devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title: Our Lady of Monte Berico. In all her apparitions this is her constant appeal: repentance and conversion to experience the love of her Son, Jesus.



**Il perdono da' gioia a Dio.**

Le letture della liturgia di oggi parlano della misericordia di Dio attraverso il perdono, e Dio gioisce e celebra quando noi, peccatori, gli diamo la possibilita' di perdonare. Spesso noi pensiamo che quando noi riceviamo il perdono e la misericordia di Dio siamo noi a godere nello spirito perche' ci viene tolto un peso di paura e ansietas per essere stati disobbedienti a Dio e aver rifiutato il suo amore. Il ragionamento del figliol prodigo che si ravvede dopo un'avventura di dissolutezza e' anche il nostro: "Padre, ho peccato contro il cielo e contro di te; non sono piu' degno di essere chiamato tuo figli. Trattami come uno dei tuoi servi". Da qui, proviamo gioia sapendo che Dio non ci rigettera' quando ritorniamo pentiti da lui. Questo e' vero e lo abbiamo sperimentato nella gioia e serenita' di cuore dopo il perdono. Ma le parabole della pecora smarrita, la moneta persa, il figlio perduto ci rivelano qualcosa di piu' importante: la vera gioia che da' motivo di celebrare e' di colui che ha ritrovato quanto aveva perduto e reabbracciare il figlio ritornato. Il perdono da' gioia a Dio. Questo rivela l'amore profondo di Dio nel dare la sua misericordia. Perdonare e averci di ritorno nel suo amore e' quanto Dio desidera perche' il perdono di Dio non e' dato a malavoglia e condizionato, ma completo, assoluto e dato con un "banchetto in festa". Quando diventiamo coscienti di questo, allora entriamo nello spirito gioioso con cui Dio manifesta la sua misericordia e desideriamo di sperimentare questo spesso. Le nostre debolezze, mancanze a imperfezioni ce ne danno motivo costante: "Io godo delle mie debolezze", diceva S. Paolo, "perche' cosi' sovrabbonda la grazia di Dio" (2Cor. 12:9). I Santi era consapevoli di questo e cercavano frequentemente il perdono di Dio. Siamo nell'Anno della Misericordia: Diamo a Dio motivo di celebrare dandoci la sua misericordia e il suo perdono. Oggi celebriamo la devozione alla Madonna sotto il titolo: Madonna di Monte Berico. In tutte le sue apparizioni il suo appello costante e': pentimento e conversione per sperimentare l'amore di Gesu'

**Origine della devozione alla Madonna di**

Verso la meta' del Marzo 1426 una donna di eta' avanzata, certa Vincenza Pasini, si recò dal Vescovo di Vicenza per raccontargli che, pochi giorni prima, il 7 Marzo, mentre si recava dal marito, che stava lavorando nella sua piccola vigna sul Monte Berico, nel luogo ove oggi sorge il Santuario, le era apparsa una donna bellissima che le aveva detto: **"Non temere, Vincenza. Io sono Maria, la Madre di Cristo morto in Croce per la salvezza del genere umano"**.
