### THE LORD'S VINEYARD:

In today's parable about the kingdom of God, Jesus talks about a vineyard that has not given any fruit. The Kingdom of God has not always been accepted and some people have rejected it in a violent way. That is why in the last part of today's parable we are told that "the Kingdom of God will be taken away" from



those who don't care and will be "given to a people that will produce its fruit". The Kingdom of God is at hand. Its seeds are present in the Church, in the world, in the families, in our parish, in our own hearts. How are we to cultivate the Lord's vinevard? 1) First and foremost being mindful that the vineyard belongs to God. We are just stewards called to be responsible and caring. We are not God. We are God's creatures and belong to God alone. 2) We are called to be labourers and to be fruitful in the vineyard planted by the Lord. The only way to be fruitful is through our unity to Jesus Christ. We are the branches united to Christ in order to produce fruits. If Jesus is not our richness we will be fruitless seeking worldly riches that will lead us to hatred, divisions and death. The labourers in the Lord's vineyard are life givers. 3) The fruits of the Lord's vineyard are to be shared. There is no room for selfishness in the Kingdom of God. Whatever has been freely given by the Lord to us is to be shared. Let us pray that the stone that the builders rejected and that has become our corner stone may always be the foundation of the kingdom that begins in our hearts. Let us make a

difference in the world by welcoming the kingdom

within us and by being fruitful with our testimony.


