Communion Antiphon: Jesus said to his disciples: Come and eat. And he took bread and gave it to them, alleluia. (Jn 21:12-13)

A reading from the First Letter of St John (5:1-6) Every one who believes that Jesus is the Christ is a child of God, and every one who loves the parent loves the child. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that overcomes the world, our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God? This is he who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ, not with water only but with the water and the blood. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

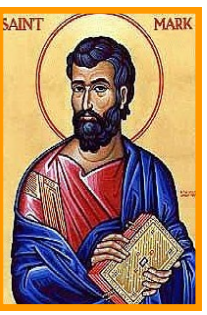

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St John (20:19-31) On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the print of the nails, and place my finger in the mark of the nails, and place my hand in his side, I will not believe." Eight days later, his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. The doors were shut, but Jesus came and stood among them, and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side; do not be faithless, but believing." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in his name. **The Gospel of the Lord.**

PEACE BE WITH YOU: Peace is one of the gifts from the Risen Lord. His peace is not the one of this world. The peace of the Risen Lord is the liberation of our darkness; it is the triumph over death. The proofs of his passion and death have remained in the empty tomb. In that tomb, according to the human concept of peace, was to remain the cause of upheavals and revolutions. But, the Risen Lord did not remain there. He left there the burial clothes and dressed the garment of glory and true peace. Now, in the Risen Lord we put our trust, not on our weaknesses and shortcomings. In Him we overcome our darkness. Embracing His new life means embracing the true peace. With His resurrection, He restores our friendship with God the Father. His peace is the transformation of the evil of this world into the deeds of redemption. His Passover goes beyond our human miseries. The Peace of the Risen Lord is not the one of tombs. The tomb remains empty because in the Risen Lord we find the true peace and freedom. Only in Him we find the answers to the questions closing us in our own tombs full of doubts and fears. Let us welcome the peace of the Risen Lord as a sign of hope, faith and charity. Let us welcome the new life as risen people of God believing and leaving behind our tombs of incredulity. Let us welcome the Risen Lord as "My Lord and my God".
