I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who humbles himself will be exalted." *The Gospel of the Lord.*

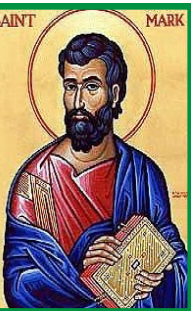

Faith in Christ Jesus saves us.

Jesus is God's gift given to humanity in love and he is the only one among all the human beings who answered God in a perfect way, in obedience and in sacrifice. This is the reason why our salvation rests on our faith in Christ. Jesus lived by three realities: humble acceptance of the human conditions, imperfect and tempted; obedience to the Father in order to re-construct the human life; sacrifice even till death

to manifest God's power to resurrect him to a new life. Jesus is a man among men but as man manifests to be a creation of God and in faithful submission allows God to complete his plan of salvation for us through him. Our faith in Christ saves us as we enter into the same attitude of Christ and his obedience toward God. Our unity in Christ makes us capable of his same trust in God as his children, even on the cross, as adopted children of God. Salvation (or justification, as St. Paul calls it), therefore, is a gift God gives to those who "imitate" Christ and "live" in Christ. Often, St. Paul says that salvation comes from faith and not from good works. The example given in the Gospel today underlines this truth. The Pharisee, in prayer in the Temple, speaks of himself and his good works, despising sinners: he leaves the Temple with no grace from God. The sinner Tax Collector, instead, humbly recognises his frail and sinful life and asks for God's mercy: he leaves the Temple forgiven and loved by God. The teaching is that in prayer we must imitate the humble attitude of Jesus and give glory to God for all that is good in us because given to us as a gift, accept humbly our human condition weak and tempted and commit ourselves to a greater obedience to God even in sacrifice. United in Christ we will bring abundant fruits of salvation. What unites us to Christ is to be humble in prayer, faithful to the sacraments, listening to the Word of God and committed to do what is good and right. This guarantees that our prayer will be heard and not rejected by God.



La Fede in Gesù salva.

Gesù è il dono di Dio dato per amore all'umanità ed è l'unico tra le persone umane che ha risposto a Dio in un modo perfetto, nell'obbedienza e sacrificio. È questo il motivo per cui la fede in Cristo salva. Tre sono gli atteggiamenti presi da Gesù: accettazione in umiltà della condizione umana imperfetta e soggetta alla tentazione; obbedienza al Padre per ricostruire la vita umana; sacrificio fino alla morte per mani-

festare la Potenza di Dio che fa risorgere a una nuova vita. Gesù è uomo tra gli uomini ma manifesta la sua fedeltà di creatura a Dio con una fedeltà filiale e così permette che Dio compia il suo piano divino per la nostra salvezza. Così la fede in Gesù ci salva mentre noi entriamo nei sentimenti e nella obbedienza di Gesù. L'unione con Cristo ci rende capaci della sua stessa "fedeltà filiale" anche fino alla croce come figli adottivi di Dio. La salvezza (o giustificazione, secondo l'espressione di S. Paolo), perciò, è dono di Dio dato a chi "imita" Cristo e "vive" in lui. S. Paolo spesso afferma che la salvezza viene dalla fede e non dalle opere. L'esempio del vangelo di oggi sottolinea questa verità: il Fariseo che, in preghiera nel tempio, si vanta delle sue bontà ed enumera le sue buone opere, esce fuori senza il favore di Dio. Il peccatore pubblicano, invece, che riconosce umilmente la sua umanità debole e peccatrice e chiede il favore della misericordia di Dio, questi ritorna perdonato e amato da Dio. L'insegnamento è che in preghiera noi dobbiamo imitare l'atteggiamento umile di Cristo e dare gloria a Dio per tutto ciò che in noi ci può essere di buono perché dono di Dio, accettare con umiltà la propria condizione umana, fragile e tentata, e impegnarci all'obbedienza della volontà di Dio anche nel sacrificio. Uniti a Cristo portiamo frutti di salvezza. In preghiera umile, partecipazione fedele ai sacramenti, ascolto sincero della parola di Dio e impegno nel compiere il bene è quanto ci unisce a Cristo e perciò garanzia di essere ascoltati e non rigettati da Dio nella preghiera.
