

**A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (2:14,36-41)**

Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed the multitude, "Let all the house of Israel therefore know assuredly that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?" **A reading from the First Letter of St Peter (2:20-25)**

What credit is it, if when you do wrong and are beaten for it you take it patiently? But if when you do right and suffer for it you take it patiently, you have God's approval. For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. He committed no sin; no guile was found on his lips. When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten; but he trusted to him who judges justly. He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. For you were straying like sheep, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

**A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St John (10:1-10)**

To him the gatekeeper opens; the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." This figure Jesus used with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them. So Jesus again said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers; but the sheep did not heed them. I am the door; if any one enters by me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly." **The Gospel of the Lord.**

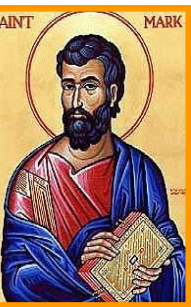

**THE GOOD SHEPHERD OFFERS HIS LIFE FOR HIS SHEEP:**

Jesus reveals himself to us as the Good Shepherd. How is He the Good Shepherd? Jesus is the way. He leads us to the Father, to safety and to the fullness of life. Without Jesus, we are lost, misguided, helpless, and even hopeless. Only in Him can we find the true way to God, to holiness and to Salvation. Jesus has also the right food for us. He is the Bread of Life. He alone gives the food that endures for eternal life. He also lays

down his life for us. The sheep are all the matter to the Shepherd. The Good Shepherd protects, defends, and promotes the well-being of the sheep. He lays down his life for the sheep. He is ready to die, to give his life for the sheep in his care. That distinguishes him from the hired man who works for pay. The hired worker flees at the least sign of danger. The challenge for us is clear. We are to know and listen to Jesus, our Good Shepherd, follow and obey him. We are to trust and depend on Jesus and remain loyal to Him. We are also to unite ourselves to Jesus, working together with our shepherd to bring other sheep to his fold. As we celebrate the world day of prayer for vocations let us pray for our priests and for holy vocations. The Good Shepherd continues taking care of us through concrete people who consecrate their lives at the service of God's kingdom. Let us pray that many will listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd calling them to serve as priests and religious.



**IL BUON PASTORE OFFRE LA VITA PER LE SUE PECORE:**

In questa domenica tutta la Chiesa prega per le vocazioni: che ogni uomo scopra il suo ruolo e la sua chiamata a diventare santo cioè come Dio, amante come lui. In questo progetto alcuni fratelli sono chiamati da Dio e dalla comunità a rendere presente il Cristo nel ministero della Parola e nella celebrazione dell'Eucarestia e del Perdono. A esempio del Buon Pastore, con tutti i loro difetti e i loro limiti, i sacerdoti diventano i pionieri di questo cammino verso il Regno. La quarta di Pasqua è detta, tradizionalmente, la "Domenica del Buon

Egli offre la sua vita per tutti: ha anche altre pecore da attirare, fino a formare un solo ovile con un solo pastore. Egli non rinuncia a nessuna pecora, anche se sono lontane o non lo conoscono. La missione della Chiesa si muove su questi parametri di universalità: vita offerta per tutti, prospettiva dell'unico ovile, vita in abbondanza. Anche se il gregge è numeroso, nessuno è in più, nessuno si perde nell'anonimato, anzi i rapporti sono personali: il pastore conosce le sue pecore e queste lo conoscono, le chiama una per una, per nome. Seguire le orme di Gesù 'il Buon Pastore' è l'obiettivo che si propone oggi la Giornata Mondiale di Preghiera per le Vocazioni, con l'invito a riflettere sul tema della "Vocazione nel mistero della Chiesa". La vocazione si rafforza solidamente nell'esperienza personale di sentirsi amato e chiamato da Qualcuno che esiste prima di te. Per qualunque tipo di vocazione, è determinante il sentire come vera questa parola di Gesù: "Conosco le mie pecore e le mie pecore conoscono me". Sentirsi nel cuore di Dio ti fa sentire vivo, grande, ti dà sicurezza, ti fa sentire figlio e fratello, fa di te un apostolo. Ascoltiamo la voce del Buon Pastore, accettiamo questo Dono di infinito amore per metterci accanto a Lui nella Morte e resurrezione. Sentiamoci veramente sicuri e protetti dalla sua Guida e manteniamoci fedeli a Lui dentro del suo gregge che è la Chiesa.

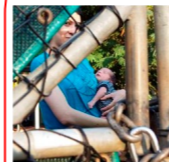
