FAITH: A light to be recovered.

As we come to the conclusion of the year of faith let us allow the words of the Holy Father to inspire us once again to keep the flame of faith shining: "There is an urgent need to see once again that faith is a light, for once the flame of faith dies out, all other lights begin to dim. The light of faith is unique, since it is capable of illuminating every aspect of human existence. A light this powerful cannot come from ourselves but from a more primordial source: in a word, it must come from God. Faith is born of an encounter with the living God who calls us and reveals his love, a love

which precedes us and upon which we can lean for security and for building our lives. Transformed by this love, we gain fresh vision, new eyes to see; we realize that it contains a great promise of fulfilment, and that a vision of the future opens up before us. Faith, received from God as a supernatural gift, becomes a light for our way, guiding our journey through time. On the one hand, it is a light coming from the past, the light of the foundational memory of the life of Jesus which revealed his perfectly trustworthy love, a love capable of triumphing over death. Yet since Christ has risen and draws us beyond death, faith is also a light coming from the future and opening before us vast horizons which guide us beyond our isolated selves towards the breadth of communion. We come to see that faith does not dwell in shadow and gloom; it is a light for our darkness." (Pope Francis, #4. Lumen Fidei). With these inspiring words let us celebrate the solemnity of Christ the King mindful that: "The light of Christ shines, as in a mirror, upon the face of Christians; as it spreads, it comes down to us, so that we too can share in that vision and reflect that light to others, in the same way that, in the Easter liturgy, the light of the paschal candle lights countless other candles. Faith is passed on, we might say, by contact, from one person to another, just as one candle is lighted from another." (#37).

Allo stesso tempo, però, poiché Cristo è risorto e ci attira oltre la morte, la fede è luce che viene dal futuro, che schiude davanti a noi orizzonti grandi, e ci porta al di là del nostro "io" isolato verso l'ampiezza della comunione. Comprendiamo allora che la fede non abita nel buio; che essa è una luce per le nostre tenebre." (Papa Francesco, # 4. Lumen Fidei). Con queste belle parole celebriamo la solennità di Cristo Re consapevoli che "La luce di Gesù brilla, come in uno specchio, sul volto dei cristiani e così si diffonde, così arriva fino a noi, perché anche noi possiamo partecipare a questa visione e riflettere ad altri la sua luce, come nella liturgia di Pasqua la luce del cero accende tante altre candele.
