In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commandment through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. To them he presented himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days, and speaking of the kingdom of God. And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "You heard from me, for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit." So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth." And when he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." The Word of the Lord.


THE ASCENSION: The Ascension is a crucial part of Christ's message and mission. He reminds his Apostles that he had come to earth in order to offer life in abundance. His suffering, death, and resurrection are source of eternal life. In the Risen Lord there is Life. He also gives his followers a mission. He calls upon them to be witness of the good news. He even promises the help of the Holy Spirit. They will not be able to carry out their witness all by themselves, they will need the Holy

Spirit, and so he promises that at Pentecost they will be "clothed with power from on high." They are to go to "all the nations" as Christ's witnesses. So, in the Ascension of our Lord, we come face to face with the missionary challenge of the Church: Christ's saving message being transmitted to all people through our witnessing to the Good News. Today, as the Church reminds us of our mission and encourages us to take it up with renewed enthusiasm, let's renew our commitment to stay close to Christ. Let's renew our commitment to daily, heartfelt prayer. Let's renew our commitment to never stop studying the treasure of the Holy Scriptures. Let's renew our commitment to make frequent and sincere use of the sacraments. On Ascension Day, Christ is sending us out into today's world to be his witnesses, just as he sent out his Apostles more than two thousand years ago. The assurance is that The Risen Lord will remain with us always: "I am with you always, until the end of times". The Ascension therefore is not being left orphans, it is about remaining with the Risen Lord in our hearts. It is not a departure but the beginning of a new presence in our hearts challenging us to continue Jesus' mission in the world. Why are you standing there looking at the sky? Let us begin doing something.


