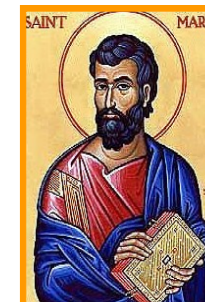

THE HOLY TRINITY: On this Holy Trinity Sunday, the Gospel presents a dialogue between two men of faith: Jesus and Nicodemus. Nicodemus is asking about his identity and Jesus is revealing himself as the manifestation of God's love in the relationship with his Father. God the Father loved the world so much that He sent his only Son to save us. Salvation therefore comes from a personal encounter with The One who was sent to save the world. This is precisely what happens with Nicodemus: he came in the middle of darkness seeking for the light and he found it in Jesus. Faith is the willingness to seek for God through a personal encounter with Jesus who is light and gives meaning to our existence. In welcoming the light of Jesus we welcome salvation. In welcoming Jesus we learn to trust in the God who is "a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness" as described in our first reading of today. As we reflect on the mystery of the Holy trinity, we reflect on the identity of God: a communion of love reaching out to us through our history. In history God reveals himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit offering us the possibility to be reconciled with God and with one another. Mindful that we carry the imprint of God within us, we are called to be compassionate, merciful and faithful like the God in whom we believe. Let us, therefore, celebrate the love of God in our history and become witnesses to His love in the world.



LA SANTISSIMA TRINITÀ: Il Vangelo di questa domenica, consacrata dalla Chiesa alla Santissima Trinità, ci parla di un dialogo molto importante tra due uomini di fede, Gesù e Nicodemo. Nicodemo, rappresentante illustre della tradizione ebraica, discute con Gesù sulla sua identità. Tutto il dialogo è una stupenda auto rivelazione di Gesù. Ma non bisogna dimenticare il contesto di questo parlare di Gesù riguardo se stesso e il Padre. Gesù non parla mai in un aula accademica in modo astratto e asettico. Infatti anche qui, in questo incontro con Nicodemo, siamo in un contesto di relazione vera. E' notte e questo fariseo si reca da Gesù per capire chi è veramente e che cosa ha da dire alla sua vita, e Gesù gli parla personalmente perché vuole

illuminare la notte del suo cuore. In molte altre parti del Vangelo Gesù parla e agisce con lo scopo preciso di toccare nel profondo e trasformare la vita delle persone che lo circondano. E' questo il Dio che Gesù rivela: un Dio che entra nella vita e manifesta la propria vita interiore per cambiare la nostra e darle luce, così come ha illuminato il cuore di Nicodemo. La fede è dunque relazione personale con Dio dentro la vita che viviamo concretamente.

La Santissima Trinità è il mistero principale della nostra fede. La storia della salvezza non è altro che il racconto delle vie e dei mezzi, con i quali Dio unico e vero, Padre e Figlio e Spirito Santo, si rivela, riconcilia e unisce a sé gli uomini. Se il mistero trinitario realizza queste meraviglie della grazia, chiama anche a noi a grandi doveri: il cristiano, figlio di Dio, deve vivere nell'amore del Padre, sull'esempio del Figlio, seguendo le ispirazioni dello Spirito, per essere testimone di fronte al mondo dell'infinita misericordia e amore di Dio. Celebrare la Santissima Trinità è celebrare l'amore di Dio manifestato nella storia.
