**A reading from the First Book of the Kings (19:16,19-21)**

The Lord said to Elijah, "Go; Elisha the son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah, you shall anoint to be prophet in your place." So he departed from there, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was ploughing, with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he was with the twelfth. Elijah passed by him and cast his mantle upon him. And he left the oxen, and ran after Elijah, and said, "Let me kiss my father and my mother, and then I will follow you." And he said to him, "Go back again; for what have I done to you?" And he returned from following him, and took the yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the yokes of the oxen, and gave it to the people, and they ate. For freedom Christ has set us free; stand fast therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love be servants of one another. For the whole law is fulfilled in one word, "You shall love your neighbour as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another take heed that you are not consumed by one another. But I say, walk by the Spirit, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh; for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you would. But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

**A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Luke (9:51-62)**

When the days drew near for Jesus to be received up, he set his face to go to Jerusalem. And he sent messengers ahead of him, who went and entered a village of the Samaritans, to make ready for him; but the people would not receive him, because his face was set towards Jerusalem. And when his disciples James and John saw it, they said, "Lord, do you want us to bid fire come down from heaven and consume them?" But he turned and rebuked them. And they went on to another village. As they were going along the road, a man said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go." And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man has nowhere to lay his head." To another he said, "Follow me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father." But he said to him, "Leave the dead to bury their own dead; but as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." Another said, "I will follow you, Lord; but let me first say farewell to those at my home." Jesus said to him, "No one who puts his hand to the plough and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God." **The Gospel of the Lord.**

**13th Sunday in Ordinary Time THE TENTH COMMANDMENT: "YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOR'S POSSESSIONS".**

**531. What is required and what is forbidden by the tenth commandment?** (2534-2540; 2551-2554) This commandment, which completes the preceding commandment, requires an interior attitude of respect for the property of others and forbids greed, unbridled covetousness for the goods of others, and envy which is the sadness one experiences at the sight of another's goods and the immoderate desire to acquire them for oneself.

**532. What does Jesus call for in poverty of spirit?** (2544-2547; 2556) Jesus calls his disciples to prefer

him to everything and everyone. Detachment from riches – in the spirit of evangelical poverty – and self-abandonment to divine providence free us from anxiety about the future and prepare us for the blessedness of the "poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Mathew 5:3).

**533. What is the greatest human desire?** (2548-2550; 2557) The greatest desire of the human person is to see God. "I want to see God" is the cry of our whole being. We realize our true and full happiness in the vision and beatitude of the One who created us out of love and draws us to himself with infinite love. "Whoever sees God has obtained all the goods of which he can conceive." (Saint Gregory of Nyssa)



**Tredicesima Domenica dell'Anno IL DECIMO COMANDAMENTO: "NON DESIDERARE LA ROBA D'ALTRI".**

**531. Che cosa richiede e che cosa proibisce il decimo Comandamento?** (2534-2540; 2551-2554) Questo Comandamento, che completa il precedente, richiede un atteggiamento interiore di rispetto nei confronti della proprietà altrui e proibisce l'avidità, la cupidigia sregolata dei beni degli altri e l'invidia, che consiste nella tristezza provata davanti ai beni altrui e nel desiderio smodato di appropriarsene.

**532. Che cosa chiede Gesù con la povertà del cuore?** (2544-2547; 2556) Ai suoi discepoli Gesù chiede di preferire Lui a tutto e a tutti. Il distacco dalle ricchezze - secondo lo spirito della povertà evangelica - e l'abbandono alla provvidenza di Dio, che ci libera dall'apprensione per il domani, preparano alla beatitudine dei «poveri in spirito, perché a loro appartiene già il regno dei cieli» (Mt 5,3).

**533. Qual è il più grande desiderio dell'uomo?** (2548-2550; 2557) Il più grande desiderio dell'uomo è vedere Dio. Questo è il grido di tutto il suo essere: «Voglio vedere Dio!». L'uomo realizza la sua vera e piena felicità nella visione e nella beatitudine di Colui che lo ha creato per amore e lo attira a sé con il suo infinito amore. «Chi vede Dio, ha conseguito tutti i beni che si possono concepire» (San Gregorio di Nissa).

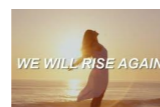

**Pray for Archbishop Peter** This weekend (Saturday 29 June) Archbishop Peter received the blessed Pallium from Pope Francis. The Pallium is a small woollen vestment (like a scarf) which is worn over Mass vestments to signify his role as the Metropolitan Archbishop of Melbourne. The Pope blesses the Pallium for each new Metropolitan Archbishop each year on the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul, and the Archbishops who receive it come back to their cities where the Apostolic Nuncio (Papal Ambassador) will formally impose the Pallium as a sign of his unity with the Pope and the Universal Church.
