**The Liturgy: The community of believers who celebrates**

(55) *Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism"*.

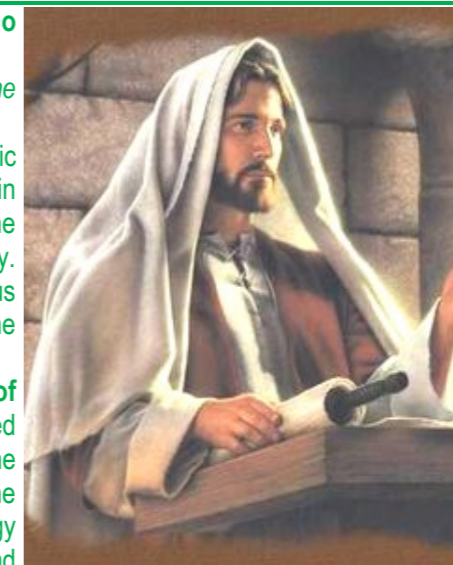
**218. What is the liturgy?** (1066-1070) The public worship which is due to God offered by the Church in unity with Christ. The liturgy is the celebration of the mystery of Christ and in particular his paschal mystery. Through the exercise of the priestly office of Jesus Christ the liturgy manifests in signs and brings about the sanctification of humankind.

**219. What place does the liturgy occupy in the life of the Church?** (1071-1076) The liturgy as the sacred action *par excellence* is the summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed and it is likewise the font from which all her power flows. Through the liturgy Christ continues the work of our redemption in, with and through his Church. Thus, the fruits of Christ's redemption through the celebration of the liturgy, most especially that of the Eucharist, are communicated to the Church "until He comes" (1 Corinthians 11:26). (220)

**221. In what way is the Father the source and the goal of the liturgy?** (1077-1083;1110) Through the liturgy the Father fills us with his blessings in the Word made flesh who died and rose for us and pours into our hearts the Holy Spirit. At the same time, the Church blesses the Father by her worship, praise, and thanks giving and begs him for the gift of his Son and the Holy Spirit.

**222. What is the work of Christ in the liturgy?** (1084-1090) By giving the Holy Spirit to his apostles he entrusted to them and their successors the power to make present the work of salvation through the Eucharistic sacrifice and the sacraments, in which he himself acts to communicate his grace to the faithful of all times and places throughout the world.

**223. How does the Holy Spirit work in the liturgy of the Church?** (1091-1109;1112) The closest cooperation is at work in the liturgy between the Holy Spirit and the Church. The Holy Spirit prepares the Church to encounter her Lord. He recalls and manifests Christ to the faith of the assembly. He makes the mystery of Christ really present. He unites the Church to the life and mission of Christ and makes the gift of communion bear fruit in the Church.



**La Liturgia: La comunita' dei fedeli che celebra**

**218. Che cos'è la liturgia?**(1066-1070) La liturgia è il culto pubblico della Chiesa dovuto a Dio celebrando il Mistero di Cristo e in particolare il suo Mistero pasquale. In essa, mediante l'esercizio dell'ufficio sacerdotale di Gesù Cristo, con segni si manifesta e si realizza la santificazione degli uomini.

**219. Che posto occupa la liturgia nella vita della Chiesa?** (1071-1075) La liturgia, azione sacra per eccellenza, costituisce il culmine verso cui tende l'azione della Chiesa e insieme la fonte da cui promana la sua forza vitale. Attraverso la liturgia, Cristo continua nella sua Chiesa, con essa e per mezzo di essa, l'opera della nostra redenzione. Mediante la celebrazione liturgica, specialmente dell'Eucarestia, vengono comunicati i frutti della redenzione di Cristo «finché egli venga» (1 Cor 11,26) (220).

**221. In che modo il Padre è la sorgente e il fine della liturgia?** (1077-1083;1110) Nella liturgia il Padre ci colma delle sue benedizioni nel Figlio incarnato, morto e risorto per noi, ed egli effonde nei nostri cuori lo Spirito Santo. Nel contempo la Chiesa benedice il Padre con l'adorazione, la lode e l'azione di grazie e implora il dono del suo Figlio e dello Spirito Santo.

**222. Qual è l'opera di Cristo nella liturgia?** (1084-1090) Nella liturgia della Chiesa, Cristo significa e realizza principalmente il proprio Mistero pasquale. Donando lo Spirito Santo agli Apostoli ha concesso loro e ai loro successori il potere di attuare l'opera della salvezza per mezzo del Sacrificio eucaristico e dei Sacramenti, nei quali egli stesso agisce per comunicare la sua grazia ai fedeli di tutti i tempi e in tutto il mondo.

**223. Nella liturgia, come opera lo Spirito Santo nei confronti della Chiesa?** (1091-1109;1112) Nella liturgia si attua la più stretta cooperazione tra lo Spirito Santo e la Chiesa. Lo Spirito Santo prepara la Chiesa ad incontrare il suo Signore; ricorda e manifesta Cristo alla fede dell'assemblea; rende presente e attualizza il Mistero di Cristo; unisce la Chiesa alla vita e alla missione di Cristo e fa fruttificare in essa il dono della comunione.

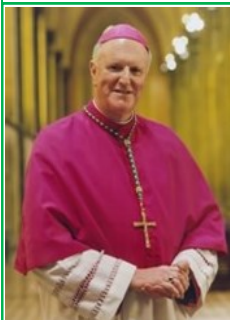
