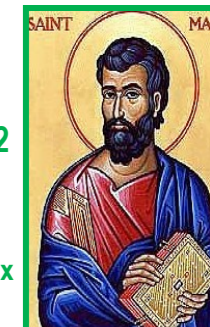

A reading from the book of Genesis (18:1-10) The Lord appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day. He lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, three men stood in front of him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them, and bowed himself to the earth, and said, "My lord, if I have found favour in your sight, do not pass by your servant. Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree, while I fetch a morsel of bread, that you may refresh yourselves, and after that you may pass on - since you have come to your servant." So they said, "Do as you have said." And Abraham hastened into the tent to Sarah, and said, "Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal, knead it, and make cakes." And Abraham ran to the herd, and took a calf, tender and good, and gave it to the servant, who hastened to prepare it. Then he took curds, and milk, and the calf which he had prepared, and set it before them; and he stood by them under the tree while they ate. They said to him, "Where is Sarah your wife?" And he said, "She is in the tent." The Lord said, "I will surely return to you in the spring, and Sarah your wife shall have a son." **The Word of the Lord.**

Responsorial Psalm:

A reading from the Letter of St Paul to the Colossian (1:24-28) I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I complete what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the sake of his body, that is, the Church, of which I became a minister according to the divine office which was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known, the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now made manifest to his saints. To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Him we proclaim, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man mature in Christ. **The Word of the Lord.**

Alleluia, alleluia! Happy are they who have kept the word with a generous heart and yield a harvest through perseverance. Alleluia! (Lk 8:15))

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Luke (10:38-42) Jesus entered a village, and a woman named Martha received him into her house. And she had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to his teaching. But Martha was distracted with much serving; and she went to him and said, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her then to help me." But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things; one thing is needful. Mary has chosen the good portion, which shall not be taken away from her." **The Gospel of the Lord.**

Communion Antiphon: The Lord, the gracious, the merciful, has made a memorial of his wonders; he gives food to those who fear him. (Ps 110:4-5)

Homily notes: 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C

A clearly identifiable and attractive theme unites today's readings: the theme of "hospitality", which in many ways runs right through the Gospel of Luke.

MARTHA AND MARY

In the Gospel, Luke 10:38-42, two sisters, Martha and Mary, give hospitality to Jesus. Martha appears to be the dominant personality. Certainly, her hospitality is more active and practical. Her sister Mary simply sits at Jesus' feet and listens. This sets up the kind of "triangular" pattern often to be seen in Luke's gospel: Jesus interacts with a character, usually someone in a marginal situation in some respect; a third character or party takes offence at this and grumbles or murmurs. Jesus defends the more marginal party, showing how her or his action is the more appropriate in terms of what he has to offer.

In this case, it is Mary, seemingly the younger sister, whom Jesus defends. While Martha has fussed about preparing too many dishes, when just one would have sufficed, Mary has "chosen the better part" - literally, "the better portion (or "dish")". In view of the identity of the One here present as guest and the gift that he has to give, it is Mary's attitude that is the more appropriate. As in the case of Abraham and his guests, hospitality is not simply flowing one way. Martha and Mary have far more to receive from their guest than he has to receive from them.

Note dell'omelia: XVI Domenica del Tempo Ordinario Anno C

Un tema chiaramente identificabile e attraente accomuna le letture di oggi: il tema dell'"ospitalità", che per molti versi attraversa il Vangelo di Luca

MARTA E MARIA

Nel Vangelo, Luca 10:38-42, due sorelle, Marta e Maria, danno ospitalità a Gesù. Marta sembra essere la personalità dominante. Certamente, la sua ospitalità è più attiva e pratica. Sua sorella Maria siede semplicemente ai piedi di Gesù e ascolta. Questo stabilisce il tipo di modello "triangolare" che spesso si vede nel vangelo di Luca: Gesù interagisce con un personaggio, di solito qualcuno in una situazione marginale sotto qualche aspetto; un terzo personaggio o parte si offende e brontola o mormora. Gesù difende il partito più marginale, mostrando come la sua azione sia la più appropriata in termini di ciò che ha da offrire.

In questo caso, è Maria, apparentemente la sorella minore, che Gesù difende. Mentre Marta si è preoccupata di preparare troppi piatti, quando solo uno sarebbe bastato, Maria ha "scelto la parte migliore" - letteralmente, "la porzione migliore (o "piatto")". In considerazione dell'identità dell'Uno qui presente come ospite e del dono che egli deve dare, è l'atteggiamento di Maria che è il più appropriato. Come nel caso di Abramo e dei suoi ospiti, l'ospitalità non scorre semplicemente in una direzione. Marta e Maria hanno molto di più da ricevere dai loro ospiti di quanto lui non abbia da ricevere da loro.

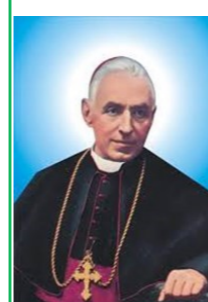

Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be to the Father for the canonization of Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini.

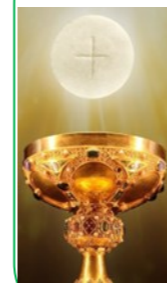

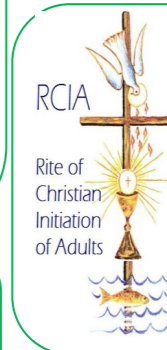

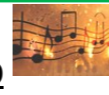
