**A reading from the book of Genesis (18:1-10)** The Lord appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day. He lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, three men stood in front of him. Him we proclaim, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man mature in Christ. ***This is the Word of the Lord.***

**THE MORAL CONSCIENCE**

**372. What is the moral conscience?** (1776-1780; 1795-1797) Moral conscience, present in the heart of the person, is a judgment of reason which at the appropriate moment enjoins him to do good and to avoid evil. Thanks to moral conscience, the human person perceives the moral quality of an act to be done or which has already been done, permitting him to assume responsibility for the act. When attentive to moral conscience, the prudent person can hear the voice of God who speaks to him or her.

**373. What does the dignity of the human person imply for the moral conscience?** (1780-1782; 1798) The dignity of a human person requires the uprightness of a moral conscience (which is to say that it be in accord with what is just and good according to reason and the law of God). Because of this personal dignity, no one may be forced to act contrary to conscience; nor, within the limits of the common good, be prevented from acting according to it, especially in religious matters.

**374. How is a moral conscience formed to be upright and truthful?** (1783-1788; 1799-1800) An upright and true moral conscience is formed by education and by assimilating the Word of God and the teaching of the Church. It is supported by the gifts of the Holy Spirit and helped by the advice of wise people. Prayer and an examination of conscience can also greatly assist one's moral formation.

**375. What norms must conscience always follow?** (1789) There are three general norms: 1) one may never do evil so that good may result from it; 2) the so-called *Golden Rule*, "Whatever you wish that men would do to you, do so to them" (*Matthew 7:12*); 3) charity always proceeds by way of respect for one's neighbor and his conscience, even though this does not mean accepting as good something that is objectively evil.

**376. Can a moral conscience make erroneous judgments?** (1790-1794; 1801-1802) A person must always obey the certain judgment of his own conscience but he could make erroneous judgments for reasons that may not always exempt him from personal guilt. However, an evil act committed through involuntary ignorance is not imputable to the person, even though the act remains objectively evil. One must therefore work to correct the errors of moral conscience.



**LA COSCIENZA MORALE**

**372. Che cos'è la coscienza morale?** (1776-1780; 1795-1797) La coscienza morale, presente nell'intimo della persona, è un giudizio della ragione, che, al momento opportuno, ingiunge all'uomo di compiere il bene e di evitare il male. Grazie ad essa, la persona umana percepisce la qualità morale di un atto da compiere o già compiuto, permettendole di assumerne la responsabilità. Quando ascolta la coscienza morale, l'uomo prudente può sentire la voce di Dio che gli parla.

**373. Che cosa implica la dignità della persona nei confronti della coscienza morale?** (1780-1782; 1798) La dignità della persona umana implica la rettitudine della coscienza morale (che cioè sia in accordo con ciò che è giusto e buono secondo la ragione e la Legge divina). A motivo della stessa dignità personale, l'uomo non deve essere

costretto ad agire contro coscienza e non si deve neppure impedirgli, entro i limiti del bene comune, di operare in conformità ad essa, soprattutto in campo religioso.

**374. Come si forma la coscienza morale perché sia retta e veritiera?** (1783-1788; 1799-1800) La coscienza morale retta e veritiera si forma con l'educazione, con l'assimilazione della Parola di Dio e dell'insegnamento della Chiesa. È sorretta dai doni dello Spirito Santo e aiutata dai consigli di persone sagge. Inoltre giovano molto alla formazione morale la preghiera e l'esame di coscienza.

**375. Quali norme la coscienza deve sempre seguire?** (1789) Ce ne sono tre più generali: 1) non è mai consentito fare il male perché ne derivi un bene; 2) la cosiddetta *Regola d'oro*: « Tutto quanto volete che gli uomini facciano a voi, anche voi fatelo a loro » (*Mt 7,12*); 3) la carità passa sempre attraverso il rispetto del prossimo e della sua coscienza, anche se questo non significa accettare come un bene ciò che è oggettivamente un male.

**376. La coscienza morale può emettere giudizi erronei?** (1790-1794; 1801-1802) La persona deve sempre obbedire al giudizio certo della propria coscienza, ma può emettere anche giudizi erronei, per cause non sempre esenti da colpevolezza personale. Non è però imputabile alla persona il male compiuto per ignoranza involontaria, anche se esso resta oggettivamente un male. È quindi necessario adoperarsi per correggere la coscienza morale dai suoi errori.

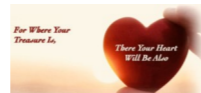

**PETITION OPPOSING THE REMOVAL OF "KEEP CLEAR" IN FRONT OF THE CHURCH ENTRANCE**

Public Transport Victoria, together with VicRoads and Yarra Trams have notified the parish that the "Keep Clear" in front of St. Brigid's **WILL BE REMOVED** for the Tram Stop Upgrades. The right hand turn from the church will no longer be permitted. The parish has been in discussion with these groups since before 2009 and we have always strongly rejected the proposal of the removal, we think with a considered adjustment to their plans the "Keep Clear" could and should stay. If you agree with the "KEEP CLEAR" NOT TO BE REMOVED, PLEASE SIGN THE PETITION. You can also take a form home and get your neighbours to sign and return it as soon as possible, this action is urgent.
