A reading from the Book of Exodus (16:2-4,12-15)

The whole congregation of the people of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness, and said to them, "Would that we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the fleshpots and ate bread to the full; for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger." Then the Lord said to Moses, "Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a day's portion everyday, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law or not. "I have heard the murmurings of the people of Israel; say to them, 'At twilight you shall eat flesh, and in the morning you shall be filled with bread; then you shall know that I am the Lord your God.'" In the evening quails came up and covered the camp; and in the morning dew lay round about the camp. And when the dew had gone up, there was on the face of the wilderness a fine, flake-like thing, fine as hoarfrost on the ground. When the people of Israel saw it, they said to one another, "What is it?" For they did not know what it was. And Moses said to them, "It is the bread which the Lord has given you to eat." **This the Word of the Lord.**



The Sacraments of the Church: Baptism

(59) Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism".

256. In what does the essential rite of Baptism consist? (1229-1245;12780) The essential rite of this sacrament consists in immersing the candidate in water or pouring water over his or her head while invoking the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

258. Why does the Church baptize infants? (1250) The Church baptizes infants because they are born with original sin. They need to be freed from the power of the Evil One and brought into that realm of freedom which belongs to the children of God.

259. What is required of one who is to be baptized? (1253-1255) Everyone who is to be baptized is required to make a profession of faith.


This is done personally in the case of an adult or by the parents and by the Church in the case of infants. Also the godfather or the godmother and the whole ecclesial community share the responsibility for baptismal preparation (catechumenate) as well as for the development and safeguarding of the faith and grace given at baptism.

261. Is Baptism necessary for salvation? (1257) Baptism is necessary for salvation for all those to whom the Gospel has been proclaimed and who have had the possibility of asking for this sacrament.

262. Is it possible to be saved without Baptism? (1258-1261;1281-1283) Since Christ died for the salvation of all, those can be saved without Baptism who die for the faith (*Baptism of blood*). Catechumens and all those who, even without knowing Christ and the Church, still (under the impulse of grace) sincerely seek God and strive to do his will can also be saved without Baptism (*Baptism of desire*). The Church in her liturgy entrusts children who die without Baptism to the mercy of God.

263. What are the effects of Baptism? (1262-1274;1279-1280) Baptism takes away original sin, all personal sins and all punishment due to sin. It makes the baptized person a participant in the divine life of the Trinity through sanctifying grace, the grace of justification which incorporates one into Christ and into his Church. It gives one a share in the priesthood of Christ and provides the basis for communion with all Christians. It bestows the theological virtues and the gifts of the Holy Spirit. A baptized person belongs forever to Christ. He is marked with the indelible seal of Christ (*character*).

264. What is the meaning of the Christian name received at Baptism? (2156-2159;2167) In Baptism a Christian receives his or her own name in the Church. It should preferably be the name of a saint who might offer the baptized a model of sanctity and an assurance of his or her intercession before God.



I Sacramenti della Chiesa: Il Battesimo

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (59)

256. In che cosa consiste il rito essenziale del Battesimo? (1229-1245;1278) Il rito essenziale di questo Sacramento consiste nell'immergere nell'acqua il candidato o nel versargli dell'acqua sul capo, mentre viene invocato il Nome del Padre e del Figlio e dello Spirito Santo.

258. Perché la Chiesa battezza i bambini? (1250) Perché, essendo nati col peccato originale, essi hanno bisogno di essere liberati dal potere del Maligno e di essere trasferiti nel regno della libertà dei figli di Dio.

259. Che cosa si richiede a un battezzando? (1253-1255) Ad ogni battezzando è richiesta la professione di fede, espressa personalmente nel caso dell'adulto, oppure

dai genitori e dalla Chiesa nel caso del bambino. Anche il padrino o la madrina e l'intera comunità ecclesiale hanno una parte di responsabilità nella preparazione al Battesimo (catechumenato), come pure nello sviluppo della fede e della grazia battesimale.

261. È necessario il Battesimo per la salvezza? (1257) Il Battesimo è necessario alla salvezza per coloro ai quali è stato annunciato il Vangelo e che hanno la possibilità di chiedere questo Sacramento.

262. Si può essere salvati senza Battesimo? (1258-1261;1281-1283) Poiché Cristo è morto per la salvezza di tutti, possono essere salvati anche senza Battesimo quanti muoiono a causa della fede (*Battesimo di sangue*), i catecumeni, e anche tutti coloro che sotto l'impulso della grazia, senza conoscere Cristo e la Chiesa, cercano sinceramente Dio e si sforzano di compiere la sua volontà (*Battesimo di desiderio*). Quanto ai bambini morti senza Battesimo, la Chiesa nella sua liturgia li affida alla misericordia di Dio.

263. Quali sono gli effetti del Battesimo? (1262-1274;1279-1280) Il Battesimo rimette il peccato originale, tutti i peccati personali e le pene dovute al peccato; fa partecipare alla vita divina trinitaria mediante la grazia santificante, la grazia della giustificazione che incorpora a Cristo e alla sua Chiesa; fa partecipare al sacerdozio di Cristo e costituisce il fondamento della comunione con tutti i cristiani; elargisce le virtù teologali e i doni dello Spirito Santo. Il battezzato appartiene per sempre a Cristo: è segnato, infatti, con il sigillo indelebile di Cristo (*carattere*).

264. Quale significato assume il nome cristiano ricevuto nel Battesimo? (2156-2159;2167) Con il Battesimo, il cristiano riceve nella Chiesa il proprio nome, preferibilmente quello di un santo, in modo che questi offra al battezzato un modello di santità e gli assicuri la sua intercessione presso Dio.
