**A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews (11:1-2,8-12)** Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the men of old received divine approval. By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place which he was to receive as an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was to go. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a foreign land, living in tents with Isaac and Jacob, heirs with him of the same promise. For he looked forward to the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God. By faith Sarah herself received power to conceive, even when she was past the age, since she considered him faithful who had promised. Therefore from one man, and him as good as dead, were born descendants as many as the stars of heaven and as the innumerable grains of sand by the seashore. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

**A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Luke (12:32-48)** Jesus said to his disciples, “Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Sell your possessions, and give alms; provide yourselves with purses that do not grow old, with a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. Let your loins be girded and your lamps burning, and be like men who are waiting for their master to come home from the marriage feast, so that they may open to him at once when he comes and knocks. Blessed are those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes; truly, I say to you, he will gird himself and have them sit at table, and he will come and serve them. If he comes in the second watch, or in the third, and finds them so, blessed are those servants! But know this, that if the householder had known at what hour the thief was coming, he would have been awake and would not have left his house to be broken into. You also must be ready; for the Son of man is coming at an hour you do not expect.” Peter said, “Lord, are you telling this parable for us or for all?” And the Lord said, “Who then is the faithful and wise steward, whom his master will set over his household, to give them their portion of food at the proper time? Blessed is that servant whom his master when he comes will find so doing. Truly I tell you, he will set him over all his possessions. But if that servant says to himself, ‘My master is delayed in coming,’ and begins to beat the menservants and the maidservants, and to eat and drink and get drunk, the master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he does not know, and will punish him, and put him with the unfaithful. And that servant who knew his master’s will, but did not make ready or act according to his will, shall receive a severe beating. But he who did not know, and did what deserved a beating, shall receive a light beating. Every one to whom much is given, of him will much be required; and of him to whom men commit much they will demand the more.”

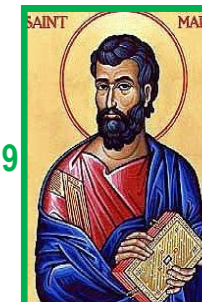

**The Seven Sacraments of the Church: Confirmation (60)** *Serialised presentation of the “Compendium of the Catechism”.*

**265. What place does Confirmation have in the divine plan of salvation?** (1285-1288;1315) In the Old Testament the prophets announced that the Spirit of the Lord would rest on the awaited Messiah and on the entire messianic people. The whole life and mission of Jesus were carried out in total communion with the Holy Spirit. The apostles received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and proclaimed “the great works of God” (Acts 2:11). They gave the gift of the same Spirit to the newly baptized by the laying on of hands. Down through the centuries, the Church has continued to live by the Spirit and to impart him to her children.

**266. Why is this sacrament called Chrismation or Confirmation?** (1289) It is called *Chrismation* (in the Eastern Churches: Anointing with holy *myron* or *chrism*) because the essential rite of the sacrament is anointing with chrism. It is called *Confirmation* because it confirms and strengthens baptismal grace.

**267. What is the essential rite of Confirmation?** (1290-1301;1318;1320-1321) The essential rite of Confirmation is the anointing with Sacred Chrism (oil mixed with balsam and consecrated by the bishop), which is done by the laying on of the hand of the minister who pronounces the sacramental words proper to the rite. In the West this anointing is done on the forehead of the baptized with the words, “Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit”. In the Eastern Churches of the Byzantine rite this anointing is also done on other parts of the body with the words, “The seal of the gift of the Holy Spirit”.

**268. What is the effect of Confirmation?** (1302-1305;1316-1317) The effect of Confirmation is a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit like that of Pentecost. This outpouring impresses on the soul an indelible character and produces a growth in the grace of Baptism. It roots the recipient more deeply in divine sonship, binds him more firmly to Christ and to the Church and reinvigorates the gifts of the Holy Spirit in his soul. It gives a special strength to witness to the Christian faith.

**389. What are the gifts of the Holy Spirit?** (1830-1831;1845)

The gifts of the Holy Spirit are permanent dispositions which make us docile in following divine inspirations. They are seven: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. **390. What are the fruits of the Holy Spirit?** (1832) The *fruits* of the Holy Spirit are perfections formed in us as the first fruits of eternal glory. The tradition of the Church lists twelve of them: charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity (Galatians 5:22-23, Vulgate).



**I Sacramenti della Chiesa:**

**La Confermazione**

*Dal Compendio del Catechismo (60)*

**265. Qual è il posto della Confermazione nel disegno divino della salvezza?** (1285-1288;1315) Nell'Antica Alleanza, i profeti hanno annunciato la comunicazione dello Spirito del Signore al Messia atteso e a tutto il popolo messianico. Tutta la vita e la missione di Gesù si svolgono in una totale comunione con lo Spirito Santo. Gli Apostoli ricevono lo Spirito Santo nella Pentecoste e annunciano «le grandi opere di Dio» (At 2,11). Essi comunicano ai neo battezzati, attraverso l'imposizione delle mani, il dono dello stesso Spirito. Lungo i secoli la Chiesa ha continuato a vivere dello Spirito e a comunicarlo ai suoi figli.

**266. Perché si chiama Cresima o Confermazione?** (1289) Si chiama *Cresima* (nelle Chiese Orientali: Crismazione col Santo Myron) a motivo del suo rito essenziale che è l'unzione. Si chiama *Confermazione*, perché conferma e rafforza la grazia battesimale.

**267. Qual è il rito essenziale della Confermazione?** (1290-1301;1318;1320-1321) Il rito essenziale della Confermazione è l'unzione con il sacro crisma (olio misto con balsamo, consacrato dal Vescovo), che si fa con l'imposizione della mano da parte del ministro che pronuncia le parole sacramentali proprie del rito. In Occidente, tale unzione viene fatta sulla fronte del battezzato con le parole: «Ricevi il sigillo dello Spirito Santo che ti è dato in dono». Presso le Chiese Orientali di rito bizantino, l'unzione viene fatta anche su altre parti del corpo, con la formula: «Sigillo del dono dello Spirito Santo».

**268. Qual è l'effetto della Confermazione?** (1302-1305;1316-1317) L'effetto della Confermazione è la speciale effusione dello Spirito Santo, come quella della Pentecoste. Tale effusione imprime nell'anima un carattere indelebile e apporta una crescita della grazia battesimale: radica più profondamente nella fili azione divina; unisce più saldamente a Cristo e alla sua Chiesa; rinvigorisce nell'anima i doni dello Spirito Santo; dona una speciale forza per testimoniare la fede cristiana.

**389. Che cosa sono i doni dello Spirito Santo?** (1830-1831;1845) I *doni* dello Spirito Santo sono disposizioni permanenti che rendono l'uomo docile a seguire le ispirazioni divine. Essi sono sette: sapienza, intelletto, consiglio, forza, scienza, pietà e timore di Dio.

**390. Che cosa sono i frutti dello Spirito Santo?** (1832) I *frutti* dello Spirito Santo sono perfezioni plasmate in noi come primizie della gloria eterna. La tradizione della Chiesa ne enumera dodici: «Amore, gioia, pace, pazienza, longanimità, bontà, benevolenza, mitezza, fedeltà, modestia, continenza, castità» (Gal 5,22-23 volg.).
