**A reading from the book of Jeremiah (38:4-6,8-10)**

The princes said to the king, "Let this man be put to death, for he is weakening the hands of the soldiers who are left in this city, and the hands of all the people, by speaking such words to them. For this man is not seeking the welfare of this people, but their harm." King Zedekiah said, "Behold, he is in your hands; for the king can do nothing against you." So they took Jeremiah and cast him into the cistern of Malchiah, the king's son, which was in the court of the guard, letting Jeremiah down by ropes. And there was no water in the cistern, but only mire, and Jeremiah sank in the mire. Ebedmelech went from the king's house and said to the king, "My lord the king, these men have done evil in all that they did to Jeremiah the prophet by casting him into the cistern; and he will die there of hunger, for there is no bread left in the city." Then the king commanded Ebedmelech, the Ethiopian, "Take three men with you from here, and lift Jeremiah the prophet out of the cistern before he dies." **This is the Word of the Lord.**

Who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or faint-hearted. In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

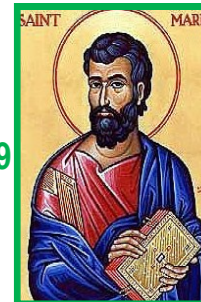

**THE THEOLOGICAL VIRTUES**

**385. Which are the theological virtues?** (1813) The theological virtues are faith, hope, and charity.

**386. What is the virtue of faith?** (1814-1816; 1842) Faith is the theological virtue by which we believe in God and all that he has revealed to us and that the Church proposes for our belief because God is Truth itself. By faith the human person freely commits himself to God. Therefore, the believer seeks to know and do the will of God because "faith works through charity" (Galatians 5:6).

**387. What is hope?** (1817-1821; 1843) Hope is the theological virtue by which we desire and await from God eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises and relying on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit to merit it and to persevere to the end of our earthly life.

**388. What is charity?** (1822-1829; 1844) Charity is the theological virtue by which we love God above all things and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God. Jesus makes charity the new commandment, the fullness of the law. "It is the bond of perfection" (Colossians 3:14) and the foundation of the other virtues to which it gives life, inspiration, and order. Without charity "I am nothing" and "I gain nothing" (1 Corinthians 13:1-3).

**389. What are the gifts of the Holy Spirit?** (1830-1831; 1845) The gifts of the Holy Spirit are permanent dispositions which make us docile in following divine inspirations. They are seven: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord.

**390. What are the fruits of the Holy Spirit?** (1832) The fruits of the Holy Spirit are perfections formed in us as the first fruits of eternal glory. The tradition of the Church lists twelve of them: charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity (Galatians 5:22-23, Vulgate).

**385. Quali sono le virtù teologali?** (1813) Le virtù teologali sono la fede, la speranza e la carità.

**386. Che cos'è la fede?** (1814-1816; 1842) La fede è la virtù teologale per la quale noi crediamo a Dio e a tutto ciò che egli ci ha rivelato e che la Chiesa ci propone di credere, perché Dio è la stessa Verità. Con la fede l'uomo si abbandona a Dio liberamente. Perciò colui che

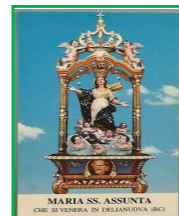
crede cerca di conoscere e fare la volontà di Dio, perché «la fede opera per mezzo della carità» (Gal 5,6).

**387. Che cos'è la speranza?** (1817-1821; 1843) La speranza è la virtù teologale per la quale noi desideriamo e aspettiamo da Dio la vita eterna come nostra felicità, riponendo la nostra fiducia nelle promesse di Cristo e appoggiandoci all'aiuto della grazia dello Spirito Santo per meritarsela e perseverare sino alla fine della vita terrena.

**388. Che cos'è la carità?** (1822-1829; 1844) La carità è la virtù teologale per la quale amiamo Dio al di sopra di tutto e il nostro prossimo come noi stessi per amore di Dio. Gesù fa di essa il comandamento nuovo, la pienezza della Legge. Essa è «il vincolo della perfezione» (Col 3,14) e il fondamento delle altre virtù, che anima, ispira e ordina: senza di essa «io non sono nulla» e «niente mi giova» (1 Cor 13,1-3).

**389. Che cosa sono i doni dello Spirito Santo?** (1830-1831; 1845) I doni dello Spirito Santo sono disposizioni permanenti che rendono l'uomo docile a seguire le ispirazioni divine. Essi sono sette: sapienza, intelletto, consiglio, forza, scienza, pietà e timore di Dio.

**390. Che cosa sono i frutti dello Spirito Santo?** (1832) I frutti dello Spirito Santo sono perfezioni plasmate in noi come primizie della gloria eterna. La tradizione della Chiesa ne enumera dodici: «Amore, gioia, pace, pazienza, longanimità, bontà, benevolenza, mitezza, fedeltà, modestia, continenza, castità» (Gal 5,22-23 volg.)
