

THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY

B - PARTICIPATION IN SOCIAL LIFE

(From: "Compendium of the Catholic Faith")

405. What is the foundation of the authority of society? (1897-1902;1918-1920) Every human community needs a legitimate authority that preserves order and contributes to the realization of the common good. The foundation of such authority lies in human nature because it corresponds to the order established by God.

406. When is authority exercised in a legitimate way? (1901-1904;1921-1922) Authority is exercised legitimately when it acts for the common good and employs morally licit means to attain it. Therefore, political regimes must be determined by the free decision of their citizens. They should respect the principle of the "rule of law" in which the law, and not the arbitrary will of some, is sovereign. Unjust laws and measures contrary to the moral order are not binding in conscience.

407. What is the common good? (1905-1906;1924) By the common good is meant the sum total of those conditions of social life which allow people as groups and as individuals to reach their proper fulfillment.

408. What is involved in the common good? (1907-1909;1925) The common good involves: respect for and promotion of the fundamental rights of the person, the development of the spiritual and temporal goods of persons and society, and the peace and security of all.

409. Where can one find the most complete realization of the common good? (1910-1912;1927) The most complete realization of the common good is found in those political communities which defend and promote the good of their citizens and of intermediate groups without forgetting the universal good of the entire human family.

410. How does one participate in bringing about the common good? (1913-1917;1926) All men and women according to the place and role that they occupy participate in promoting the common good by respecting just laws and taking charge of the areas for which they have personal responsibility such as the care of their own family and the commitment to their own work. Citizens also should take an active part in public life as far as possible.

B - LA PARTECIPAZIONE ALLA VITA SOCIALE

405. Su che cosa si fonda l'autorità nella società? (1897-1902;1918-1920) Ogni comunità umana ha bisogno di un'autorità legittima, che assicuri l'ordine e contribuisca all'attuazione del bene comune. Tale autorità trova il proprio fondamento nella natura umana, perché corrisponde all'ordine stabilito da Dio.

406. Quando l'autorità è esercitata in modo legittimo? (1901,1903-1904;1921-1922)

L'autorità è esercitata in modo legittimo quando agisce per il bene comune e per conseguirlo usa mezzi moralmente liciti. Perciò i regimi politici devono essere determinati dalla libera decisione dei cittadini e devono rispettare il principio dello «Stato di diritto», nel quale è sovrana la legge, e non la volontà arbitraria degli uomini. Le leggi ingiuste e le misure contrarie all'ordine morale non sono obbliganti per le coscienze.

407. Che cos'è il bene comune? (1905-1906;1924) Per bene comune si intende l'insieme di quelle condizioni di vita sociale che permettono ai gruppi e ai singoli di realizzare la propria perfezione.

408. Che cosa comporta il bene comune? (1907-1909;1925)

Il bene comune comporta: il rispetto e la promozione dei diritti fondamentali della persona; lo sviluppo dei beni spirituali e temporali delle persone e della società; la pace e la sicurezza di tutti.

409. Dove si realizza in maniera più rilevante il bene comune? (1910-1912;1927) La realizzazione più completa del bene comune si trova in quelle comunità politiche, che difendono e promuovono il bene dei cittadini e dei ceti intermedi, senza dimenticare il bene universale della famiglia umana.

410. Come l'uomo partecipa alla realizzazione del bene comune? (1913-1917;1926) Ogni uomo, secondo il posto e il ruolo che ricopre, partecipa a promuovere il bene comune, rispettando le leggi giuste e facendosi carico dei settori di cui ha la responsabilità personale, quali la cura della propria famiglia e l'impegno nel proprio lavoro. I cittadini inoltre, per quanto è possibile, devono prendere parte attiva alla vita pubblica.
