I, Paul, an ambassador and now a prisoner also for Christ Jesus – I appeal to you for my child, Onesimus, whose father I have become in my imprisonment. I am sending him back to you, sending my very heart. I would have been glad to keep him with me, in order that he might serve me on your behalf during my imprisonment for the gospel; but I preferred to do nothing without your consent in order that your goodness might not be by compulsion but of your own free will. Perhaps this is why he was parted from you for a while, that you might have him back for ever, no longer as a slave but more than a slave, as a beloved brother, especially to me but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord. So if you consider me your partner, receive him as you would receive me. *This is the Word of the Lord.*

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Luke (14:25-33)

Great multitudes accompanied Jesus; and he turned and said to them, “If any one comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me, cannot be my disciple. For which of you, desiring to build a tower, does not first sit down and count the cost, whether he has enough to complete it? Otherwise, when he has laid a foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, saying, ‘This man began to build, and was not able to finish.’ Or what king, going to encounter another king in war, will not sit down first and take counsel whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? And if not, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends an embassy and asks terms of peace. So therefore, whoever of you does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple.” *The Gospel of the Lord.*

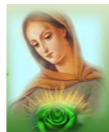
Communion: AS THE DEER

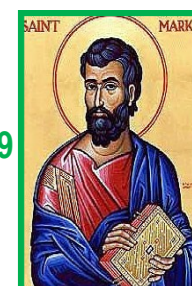

Origine della devozione alla Madonna di Monte Berico che si venera nella Chiesa di Santa Brigida in Nth Fitzroy Melbourne
Nei primi decenni del 1400 una pestilenza ostinata mieteva vittime nel Vicentino. Verso la metà del Marzo 1426 una donna di età avanzata, certa Vincenza Pasini, si recò dal Vescovo di Vicenza per raccontargli che, pochi giorni prima, il 7 Marzo, mentre si recava dal marito, che stava lavorando nella sua piccola vigna sul Monte Berico, nel luogo ove oggi sorge il Santuario, le era apparsa una donna bellissima che le aveva detto: **"Non temere, Vincenza. Io sono Maria, la Madre di Cristo morto in Croce per la salvezza del genere umano"**.

SOCIAL JUSTICE

- 411. How does society ensure social justice?** (1928-1933;1943-1944) Society ensures social justice when it respects the dignity and the rights of the person as the proper end of society itself. Furthermore, society pursues social justice, which is linked to the common good and to the exercise of authority, when it provides the conditions that allow associations and individuals to obtain what is their due.
- 412. On what is human equality based?** (1934-1935;1945) All persons enjoy equal dignity and fundamental rights insofar as they are created in the image of the one God, are endowed with the same rational soul, have the same nature and origin, and are called in Christ, the one and only Savior, to the same divine beatitude.
- 413. How are we to view social inequalities?** (1936-1938;1946-1947) There are sinful social and economic inequalities which affect millions of human beings. These inequalities are in open contradiction to the Gospel and are contrary to justice, to the dignity of persons, and to peace. There are, however, differences among people caused by various factors which enter into the plan of God. Indeed, God wills that each might receive what he or she needs from others and that those endowed with particular talents should share them with others. Such differences encourage and often oblige people to the practice of generosity, kindness and the sharing of goods. They also foster the mutual enrichment of cultures.
- 414. How is human solidarity manifested?** (1939-1942;1948) Solidarity, which springs from human and Christian brotherhood, is manifested in the first place by the just distribution of goods, by a fair remuneration for work and by zeal for a more just social order. The virtue of solidarity also practices the sharing of the spiritual goods of faith which is even more important than sharing material goods.

LA GIUSTIZIA SOCIALE

- 411. Come la società assicura la giustizia sociale?** (1928-1933;1943-1944) La società assicura la giustizia sociale quando rispetta la dignità e i diritti della persona, fine proprio della società stessa. Inoltre la società persegue la giustizia sociale, che è connessa con il bene comune e l'esercizio dell'autorità, quando realizza le condizioni che consentono alle associazioni e agli individui di conseguire ciò a cui hanno diritto.
- 412. Su che cosa si fonda l'uguaglianza tra gli uomini?** (1934-1935;1945) Tutti gli uomini godono di eguale dignità e diritti fondamentali, in quanto, creati a immagine dell'unico Dio e dotati di una medesima anima razionale, hanno la stessa natura e origine, e sono chiamati, in Cristo unico salvatore, alla medesima beatitudine divina.
- 413. Come valutare le disuguaglianze tra gli uomini?** (1936-1938;1946-1947) Ci sono delle disuguaglianze inique, economiche e sociali, che colpiscono milioni di esseri umani; esse sono in aperto contrasto con il Vangelo, contrarie alla giustizia, alla dignità delle persone, alla pace. Ma ci sono anche differenze tra gli uomini, causate da vari fattori, che rientrano nel piano di Dio. Infatti, Egli vuole che ciascuno riceva dagli altri ciò di cui ha bisogno, e che coloro che hanno «talenti» particolari li condividano con gli altri. Tali differenze incoraggiano e spesso obbligano le persone alla magnanimità, alla benevolenza e alla condivisione, e spingono le culture a mutui arricchimenti.
- 414. Come si esprime la solidarietà umana?** (1939-1942;1948) La solidarietà, che scaturisce dalla fraternità umana e cristiana, si esprime anzitutto nella giusta ripartizione dei beni, nella equa remunerazione del lavoro e nell'impegno per un ordine sociale più giusto. La virtù della solidarietà attua anche la condivisione dei beni spirituali della fede, ancor più importanti di quelli materiali.
