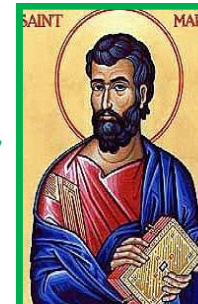

Origine della devozione alla Madonna di Monte Berico che si venera nella Chiesa di Santa Brigida in Nth Fitzroy Melbourne
Nei primi decenni del 1400 una pestilenza ostinata mieteva vittime nel Vicentino. Verso la metà del Marzo 1426 una donna di età avanzata, certa Vincenza Pasini, si recò dal Vescovo di Vicenza per raccontargli che, pochi giorni prima, il 7 Marzo, mentre si recava dal marito, che stava lavorando nella sua piccola vigna sul Monte Berico, nel luogo ove oggi sorge il Santuario, le era apparsa una donna bellissima che le aveva detto: **"Non temere, Vincenza. Io sono Maria, la Madre di Cristo morto in Croce per la salvezza del genere umano"**.

THE APOSTLES' CREED: The Trinity

46. What did Jesus Christ reveal to us about the mystery of the Father? (240-242)

Jesus Christ revealed to us that God is "Father", not only insofar as he created the universe and the mankind, but above all because he eternally generated in his bosom the Son who is his Word, "the radiance of the glory of God and the very stamp of his nature" (Hebrews 1:3).

47. Who is the Holy Spirit revealed to us by Jesus Christ? (243-248) The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Most Blessed Trinity. He is God, one and equal with the Father and the Son. He "proceeds from the Father" (John 15:26) who is the principle without a principle and the origin of all trinitarian life. He proceeds also from the Son (Filioque) by the eternal Gift which the Father makes of him to the Son. Sent by the Father and the Incarnate Son, the Holy Spirit guides the Church "to know all truth" (John 16:13).

48. How does the Church express her trinitarian faith? (249-256; 266) The Church expresses her trinitarian faith by professing a belief in the oneness of God in whom there are three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The three divine Persons are only one God because each of them equally possesses the fullness of the one and indivisible divine nature. They are really distinct from each other by reason of the relations which place them in correspondence to each other. The Father generates the Son; the Son is generated by the Father; the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son.

49. How do the three divine Persons work? (257-260; 267) Inseparable in their one substance, the three divine Persons are also inseparable in their activity. The Trinity has one operation, sole and the same. In this one divine action, however, each Person is present according to the mode which is proper to him in the Trinity. "O my God, Trinity whom I adore...grant my soul peace; make it your heaven, your beloved dwelling, and the place of your rest. May I never abandon you there, but may I be there, whole and entire, completely vigilant in my faith, entirely adoring, and wholly given over to your creative action." (Blessed Elizabeth of the Trinity)

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (22)

LA PROFESSIONE DI FEDE: La Trinità'

46. Che cosa Gesù Cristo ci rivela del mistero del Padre? (240-242) Gesù Cristo ci rivela che Dio è «Padre», non solo in quanto è Creatore dell'universo e dell'uomo, ma soprattutto perché genera eternamente nel suo seno il Figlio, che è il suo Verbo, «irradiazione della sua gloria, impronta della sua sostanza» (Eb 1,3).

47. Chi è lo Spirito Santo, rivelato a noi da Gesù Cristo? (243-248) È la terza Persona della Santissima Trinità. È Dio, uno e uguale al Padre e al Figlio. Egli «procede dal Padre» (Gv 15,26), il quale, principio senza principio, è l'origine di tutta la vita trinitaria. E procede anche dal Figlio (Filioque), per il dono eterno che il Padre ne fa al Figlio. Inviato dal Padre e dal Figlio incarnato, lo Spirito Santo guida la Chiesa «a conoscere la Verità tutta intera» (Gv 16,13).

48. Come la Chiesa esprime la sua fede trinitaria?(249-256;266) La Chiesa esprime la sua fede trinitaria confessando un solo Dio in tre Persone: Padre e Figlio e Spirito Santo. Le tre Persone divine sono un solo Dio perché ciascuna di esse è identica alla pienezza dell'unica e indivisibile natura divina. Esse sono realmente distinte tra loro, per le relazioni che le mettono in riferimento le une alle altre: il Padre genera il Figlio, il Figlio è generato dal Padre, lo Spirito Santo procede dal Padre e dal Figlio.

49. Come operano le tre Persone divine? (257-260;267) Inseparabili nella loro unica sostanza, le Persone divine sono inseparabili anche nel loro operare: la Trinità ha una sola e medesima operazione. Ma, nell'unico agire divino, ogni Persona è presente secondo il modo che le è proprio nella Trinità. «O mio Dio, Trinità che adoro... pacifica la mia anima; fanne il tuo cielo, la tua dimora amata e il luogo del tuo riposo. Che io non ti lasci mai sola, ma che sia lì, con tutta me stessa, tutta vigile nella mia fede, tutta adorante, tutta offerta alla tua azione creatrice» (Beata Elisabetta della Trinità).
