

Origine della devozione alla Madonna di Monte Berico che si venera nella Chiesa di Santa Brigida in Nth Fitzroy Melbourne

Nei primi decenni del 1400 una pestilenza ostinata mieteva vittime nel Vicentino. Verso la metà del Marzo 1426 una donna di età avanzata, certa Vincenza Pasini, si recò dal Vescovo di Vicenza per raccontargli che, pochi giorni prima, il 7 Marzo, mentre si recava dal marito, che stava lavorando nella sua piccola vigna sul Monte Berico, nel luogo ove oggi sorge il Santuario, le era apparsa una donna bellissima che le aveva detto: "Non temere, Vincenza. Io sono Maria, la Madre di Cristo morto in Croce per la salvezza del genere umano".

### The Sacrament of the Church: The Eucharist

(58) Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism"

**285. How long does the presence of Christ last in the Eucharist?**

(1377) The presence of Christ continues in the Eucharist as long as the eucharistic species subsist.

**286. What kind of worship is due to the sacrament of the Eucharist?**

(1378-1381;1418) The worship due to the sacrament of the Eucharist, whether during the celebration of the Mass or outside it, is the worship of *latra*, that is, the adoration given to God alone. The Church guards with the greatest care Hosts that have been consecrated. She brings them to the sick and to other persons who find it impossible to participate at Mass. She also presents them for the solemn adoration of the faithful and she bears them in processions. The Church encourages the faithful to make frequent visits to adore the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle.

**287. Why is the Holy Eucharist the paschal banquet?** (1382-1384;1391-1396) The Holy Eucharist is the paschal banquet in as much as Christ sacramentally makes present his Passover and gives us his Body and Blood, offered as food and drink, uniting us to himself and to one another in his sacrifice.

**288. When does the Church oblige her members to participate at Holy Mass?** (1389;1417) The Church obliges the faithful to participate at Holy Mass every Sunday and on holy days of obligation. She recommends participation at Holy Mass on other days as well.

**289. When must one receive Holy Communion?** (1389) The Church recommends that the faithful, if they have the required dispositions, receive Holy Communion whenever they participate at Holy Mass. However, the Church obliges them to receive Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season.

### I Sacramenti della Chiesa: L'Eucarestia

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (58)

**285. Fino a quando continua la presenza eucaristica di Cristo?** (1377) Essa continua finché sussistono le specie eucaristiche.

**286. Quale tipo di culto è dovuto al Sacramento dell'Eucaristia?** (1378-1381;1418) È dovuto il culto di *latra*, cioè di adorazione, riservato solo a Dio sia durante la celebrazione eucaristica sia al di fuori di essa. La Chiesa, infatti, conserva con la massima diligenza le Ostie consurate, le porta agli infermi e ad altre persone impossibilitate a partecipare alla Santa Messa, le presenta alla solenne adorazione dei fedeli, le porta in processione e invita alla frequente visita e adorazione del Santissimo Sacramento conservato nel tabernacolo.

**287. Perché l'Eucaristia è il banchetto pasquale?** (1382-1384;1391-1396) L'Eucaristia è il banchetto pasquale, in quanto Cristo, realizzando sacramentalmente la sua Pasqua, ci dona il suo Corpo e il suo Sangue, offerti come cibo e bevanda, e ci unisce a sé e tra di noi nel suo sacrificio.

**288. Quando la Chiesa fa obbligo di partecipare alla santa Messa?** (1389;1417) La Chiesa fa obbligo ai fedeli di partecipare alla santa Messa ogni domenica e nelle feste di pre-cetto, e raccomanda di parteciparvi anche negli altri giorni.

**289. Quando si deve fare la santa Comunione?** (1389) La Chiesa raccomanda ai fedeli che partecipano alla santa Messa di ricevere con le dovute disposizioni anche la santa Comunione, prescrivendone l'obbligo almeno a Pasqua.
