You have lived on the earth in luxury and in pleasure; you have fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter. You have condemned, you have killed the righteous man; he does not resist you.

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Mark(9:38-43,45,47-48)

John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw a man casting out demons in your name, and we forbade him, because he was not following us." But Jesus said, "Do not forbid him; for no one who does a mighty work in my name will be able soon after to speak evil of me. For he that is not against us is for us. For truly, I say to you, whoever gives you a cup of water to drink because you bear the name of Christ, will by no means lose his reward. "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were hung round his neck and he were thrown into the sea. And if your hand causes you to sin, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life maimed than with two hands to go to hell, to the unquenchable fire. And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life lame than with two feet to be thrown into hell. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into hell, where their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched. *The Gospel of the Lord.*

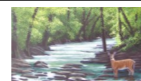

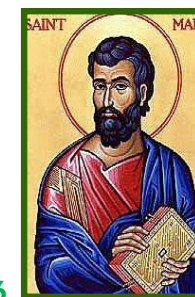

THE SACRAMENTS: Unite us in Christ.

(67) *Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism"*

224. What are the sacraments and which are they? (1113-1131) The sacraments, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, are efficacious signs of grace perceptible to the senses. Through them divine life is bestowed upon us. There are seven sacraments: **Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist, Penance, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders, and Matrimony.**

220. In what does the sacramental economy consist? (1076) The sacramental economy consists in the communication of the fruits of Christ's redemption through the celebration of the sacraments of the Church, most especially that of the Eucharist, "until he comes".

(1 Corinthians 11:26).

225. What is the relationship of the sacraments to Christ? (1114-1116) The mysteries of Christ's life are the foundations of what he would henceforth dispense in the sacraments, through the ministers of his Church. "What was visible in our Savior has passed over into his mysteries." (Saint Leo the Great)

226. What is the link between the sacraments and the Church? (1117-1119) Christ has entrusted the sacraments to his Church. They are the sacraments "of the Church" in a twofold sense: they are "from her" insofar as they are actions of the Church which is the sacrament of Christ's action; and they are "for her" in as much as they build up the Church.

227. What is the sacramental character? (1121) It is a spiritual "seal" bestowed by the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. It is a promise and guarantee of divine protection. By virtue of this seal the Christian is configured to Christ, participates in a variety of ways in his priesthood and takes his part in the Church according to different states and functions. He is, therefore, set apart for divine worship and the service of the Church. Because this character is indelible the sacraments that impress it on the soul are received only once in life.

228. What is the relationship between the sacraments and faith? (1122-1126;1133) The sacraments not only presuppose faith but with words and ritual elements they nourish, strengthen, and express it. By celebrating the sacraments, the Church professes the faith that comes from the apostles. This explains the origin of the ancient saying, "lex orandi, lex credendi," that is, the Church believes as she prays.



I SACRAMENTI: Ci uniscono in Cristo.

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (67)

224. Che cosa sono i Sacramenti e quali sono? (1113-1131) I Sacramenti sono segni sensibili ed efficaci della grazia, istituiti da Cristo e affidati alla Chiesa, attraverso i quali ci viene elargita la vita divina. Sono sette: il **Battesimo, la Confermazione, l'Eucaristia, la Penitenza, l'Unzione degli infermi, l'Ordine e il Matrimonio.**

220. In che cosa consiste l'economia sacramentale? (1076) L'economia sacramentale consiste nel comunicare i frutti della redenzione di Cristo, mediante la celebrazione dei sacramenti della Chiesa, massimamente dell'Eucaristia, «finché egli venga» (1 Cor 11,26).

225. Qual è il rapporto dei Sacramenti con Cristo? (1114-1116) I misteri della vita di Cristo costituiscono il fondamento di ciò che adesso Cristo, mediante i ministri della Chiesa, dispensa nei Sacramenti. «Ciò che era visibile nel nostro Salvatore è passato nei suoi sacramenti» (San Leone Magno).

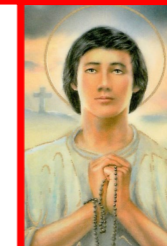
226. Qual è il legame dei Sacramenti con la Chiesa? (1117-1119) Cristo ha affidato i Sacramenti alla sua Chiesa. Essi sono «della Chiesa», in un duplice significato: sono «da essa», in quanto sono azioni della Chiesa, la quale è sacramento dell'azione di Cristo; e sono «per essa», nel senso che edificano la Chiesa.

227. Che cos'è il carattere sacramentale? (1121) È un sigillo spirituale, conferito dai Sacramenti del Battesimo, della Confermazione e dell'Ordine. Esso è promessa e garanzia della protezione divina. In forza di tale sigillo il cristiano è configurato a Cristo, partecipa in vario modo al suo sacerdozio e fa parte della Chiesa secondo stati e funzioni diverse. Viene quindi consacrato al culto divino e al servizio della Chiesa. Poiché il carattere è indelebile, i Sacramenti, che lo imprimono, si ricevono una volta sola nella vita.

228. Qual è la relazione dei Sacramenti con la fede? (1122-1126;1133) I Sacramenti non solo suppongono la fede, ma con le parole e con gli elementi rituali la nutrono, la irrobustiscono e la esprimono. Celebrando i Sacramenti, la Chiesa confessa la fede apostolica. Da qui viene l'antico detto: «Lex orandi, lex credendi», cioè la Chiesa crede come prega.
