

**Homily notes:**

There is a sharp social justice focus in the Scripture today.

Ultimately, then, the parable is about conversion and about the difficulty that riches and luxury put in its way. This becomes clearer in the epilogue following the main story.


Realising the hopelessness of his own situation, the man wants Lazarus sent on an errand to warn his five brothers before they too end up in the same fate. Abraham suggests that what they need to hear is contained already in the Scriptures (OT), which contain ample warnings about the need to care for the widow, the orphan, the needy stranger at the door (Deut 10:18; 24:19, 21; 27:19; Ps 94:6; Isa 1:7; Jer 22:3; Zech 7:10; etc.). But the rich man knows that this will not be enough to change his brothers.

Knowingly, Abraham replies, "If they do not listen to scripture, neither will they be convinced even if someone rises from the dead".

In the story the one who would come back from the dead would of course be Lazarus. Christian readers, however, would not fail to hear an allusion to the risen Lord.

The story points up the difficulty that even believers have in hearing the gospel of social justice. It does not cease to grow in relevance in a world where so much of the population sits like Lazarus outside the door.

In definitiva, quindi, la parabola riguarda la conversione e la difficoltà che la ricchezza e il lusso mettono sulla sua strada. Questo diventa più chiaro nell'epilogo che segue la storia principale. Rendendosi conto della disperazione della propria situazione, l'uomo vuole che Lazzaro sia mandato in missione per avvertire i suoi cinque fratelli prima che anch'essi finiscano nella stessa sorte. Abramo suggerisce che ciò che hanno bisogno di sentire è già contenuto nelle Scritture (OT), che contengono ampi avvertimenti sulla necessità di prendersi cura della vedova, dell'orfano, dello straniero bisognoso alla porta


(Dt 10:18; 24:19, 21; 27:19; Sal 94:6; Isa 1:7; Ger 22:3; Zech 7:10; ecc.). Ma il ricco sa che questo non basterà a cambiare i suoi fratelli.

Consapevolmente, Abramo risponde: "Se non ascoltano la Scrittura, non saranno convinti nemmeno se qualcuno risorge dai morti".

Nella storia colui che sarebbe tornato dalla morte sarebbe ovviamente Lazzaro. I lettori cristiani, tuttavia, non mancherebbero di ascoltare un'allusione al Signore risorto.

La storia indica la difficoltà che anche i credenti hanno nell'ascoltare il vangelo della giustizia sociale. Non cessa di crescere in importanza in un mondo in cui gran parte della popolazione siede come Lazzaro fuori dalla porta.

**Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be to the Father for the canonization of Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini.**



