A reading from the Letter of St Paul to the Philippians (2:1-11) If there is any encouragement in Christ, any incentive of love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from selfishness or conceit, but in humility count others better than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

Alleluia, alleluia! If anyone loves me he will keep my word and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him. **Alleluia!** (Jn 14:23)

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Matthew (21:28-32)
Jesus said to the chief priests and the elders of the people, "What do you think? A man had two sons; and he went to the first and said, 'Son, go and work in the vineyard today'. And he answered, 'I will not'; but afterwards he repented and went. And he went to the second and said the same; and he answered, 'I go, sir', but did not go. Which of the two did the will of his father?" They said, "The first." Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, the tax collectors and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you. For John came to you in the way of righteousness, and you did not believe him, but the tax collectors and the harlots believed him; and even when you saw it, you did not afterwards repent and believe him." **Gospel of the Lord.**

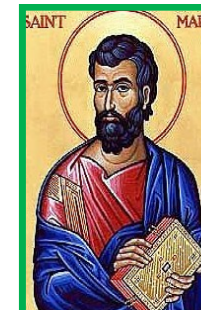

**The Apostles' Creed (continue):
Man created in the "image of God"**
66. In what sense do we understand man and woman as created "in the image of God"? (355-357)

The human person is created in the image of God in the sense that he or she is capable of knowing and of loving their Creator in freedom. Human beings are the only creatures on earth that God has willed for their own sake and has called to share, through knowledge and love, in his own divine life. All human beings, in as much as they are created in the image of God, have the dignity of a person. A person is not something but someone, capable of self-knowledge and of freely giving himself and entering into communion with God and with other persons. **67. For what purpose did God create man and woman?** (358-359; 380-381) God has created everything for them; but he has created them to know, serve and love God, to offer all of creation in this world in thanksgiving back to him and to be raised up to life with him in heaven. Only in the mystery of the incarnate Word does the mystery of the human person come into true light. Man and woman are predestined to reproduce the image of the Son of God made Man, who is the perfect "image of the invisible God" (Colossians 1:15).

69. How do the soul and body form a unity in the human being? (362-365; 382) The human person is a being at once corporeal and spiritual. In man spirit and matter form one nature. This unity is so profound that, thanks to the spiritual principle which is the soul, the body which is material, becomes a living human body and participates in the dignity of the image of God.

70. Where does the soul come from? (366-368; 382) The spiritual soul does not come from one's parents but is created immediately by God and is immortal. It does not perish at the moment when it is separated from the body in death and it will be once again reunited with the body at the moment of the final resurrection.

71. What relationship has God established between man and woman? (369-373; 383) Man and woman have been created by God in equal dignity insofar as they are human persons. At the same time, they have been created in a reciprocal complementarity insofar as they are masculine and feminine. God has willed them one for the other to form a communion of persons. They are also called to transmit human life by forming in matrimony "one flesh" (Genesis 2:24). They are likewise called to subdue the earth as "stewards" of God.



Dal Compendio del Catechismo (25)
**LA PROFESSIONE DI FEDE:
L'uomo creato a "Immagine di Dio"**
66. In che senso l'uomo è creato a «immagine di Dio»? (355-357) L'uomo è creato a immagine di Dio nel senso che è capace di conoscere e di amare, nella libertà, il proprio Creatore. È la sola creatura, su questa terra, che Dio ha voluto per se stessa e che ha chiamato a condividere, nella conoscenza e nell'amore, la sua vita divina. Egli, in quanto creato a immagine di Dio, ha la dignità di persona: non è qualcosa, ma qualcuno, capace di conoscersi, di donarsi liberamente e di entrare in comunione con Dio e con le altre persone.

67. Per quale fine Dio ha creato l'uomo? (358-359) Dio ha creato tutto per l'uomo, ma l'uomo è stato creato per conoscere, servire e amare Dio, per offrirgli, in questo mondo, tutta la creazione in rendimento di grazie ed essere elevato alla vita con Dio in cielo. Solamente nel mistero del Verbo incarnato trova vera luce il mistero dell'uomo predestinato a riprodurre l'immagine del Figlio di Dio fatto uomo, che è la perfetta «immagine del Dio invisibile» (Col 1,15).

69. Come nell'uomo l'anima e il corpo formano un'unità? (362-365;382) La persona umana è un essere insieme corporeo e spirituale. Nell'uomo lo spirito e la materia formano un'unica natura. Questa unità è così profonda che, grazie al principio spirituale che è l'anima, il corpo, che è materiale, diventa un corpo umano e vivente, e partecipa alla dignità di immagine di Dio.

70. Chi dona l'anima all'uomo? (366-368;382) L'anima spirituale non viene dai genitori, ma è creata direttamente da Dio, ed è immortale. Separandosi dal corpo al momento della morte, essa non perisce; si unirà nuovamente al corpo nel momento della risurrezione finale.

71. Quale relazione Dio ha posto tra l'uomo e la donna? (369-373;383) L'uomo e la donna sono stati creati da Dio in uguale dignità in quanto persone umane, e, nello stesso tempo, in una reciproca complementarietà, essendo maschio e femmina. Dio li ha voluti l'uno per l'altro, per una comunione di persone. Insieme sono anche chiamati a trasmettere la vita umana, formando nel matrimonio «una sola carne» (Gn 2,24), e a dominare la terra come «amministratori» di Dio.
