





THE CHURCH, MOTHER AND TEACHER 429. How does the Church nourish the moral life of a Christian? (2030-2031;2047) The Church is the community in which the Christian receives the Word of God, the teachings of the "Law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2), and the grace of the sacraments. Christians are united to the Eucharistic sacrifice of Christ in such a way that their moral life is an act of spiritual worship; and they learn the example of holiness from the Virgin Mary and the lives of the Saints.



431. What purpose do the precepts of the Church have? (2041;2048) The five precepts of the Church are meant to guarantee for the faithful the indispensable minimum in the spirit of prayer, the sacramental life, moral commitment and growth in love of God and neighbor.

432. What are the precepts of the Church? (2042-2043) They are: 1) to attend Mass on Sundays and other holy days of obligation and to refrain from work and activities which could impede the sanctification of those days; 2) to confess one's sins, receiving the sacrament of Reconciliation at least once each year; 3) to receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season; 4) to abstain from eating meat and to observe the days of fasting established by the Church; and 5) to help to provide for the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability. 433. Why is the Christian moral life indispensable for the proclamation of the Gospel (2044-2046) Because their lives are conformed to the Lord Jesus, Christians draw others to faith in the true God, build up the Church, inform the world with the spirit of the Gospel, and hasten the coming of the Kingdom of God.

Tale compito si estende anche alle prescrizioni specifiche della legge naturale, perché la loro osservanza è necessaria per la salvezza.

431. Quali finalità hanno i precetti della Chiesa? (2041;2048) I cinque precetti della Chiesa hanno come fine di garantire ai fedeli il minimo indispensabile dello spirito di preghiera, della vita sacramentale, dell'impegno morale e della crescita dell'amore di Dio e del prossimo.

432. Quali sono i precetti della Chiesa? (2042-2043) Essi sono: 1) partecipare alla Messa la domenica e le altre feste comandate e rimanere liberi da lavori e da attività che potrebbero impedire la santificazione di tali giorni; 2) confessare i propri peccati, ricevendo il Sacramento della Riconciliazione almeno una volta all'anno: 3) accostarsi al Sacramento dell'Eucaristia almeno a Pasqua; 4) astenersi dal mangiare carne e osservare il digiuno nei giorni stabiliti dalla Chiesa; 5) sovvenire alle necessità materiali della Chiesa, ciascuno secondo le proprie possibilità. 433. Perché la vita morale dei cristiani è indispensabile per l'annunzio del Vangelo? (2044-2046) Perché con la loro vita conforme al Signore Gesù i cristiani attirano gli uomini alla fede nel vero Dio, edificano la Chiesa, informano il mondo con lo spirito del Vangelo e affrettano la venuta del Regno di Dio.
