

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Within your will, O Lord, all things are established, and there is none that can resist your will. For you have made all things, the heaven and the earth, and all that is held within the circle of heaven; you are the Lord of all (Est 4:17).

A reading from the Book of Genesis (2:18-24)

The Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him." So out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name. The man gave names to all cattle, and to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for the man there was not found a helper fit for him. So the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and while he slept took one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh; and the rib which the Lord God had taken from the man he made into a woman and brought her to the man. Then the man said, "This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." Therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and cleaves to his wife, and they become one flesh. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews (2:9-11)

We see Jesus, who for a little while was made lower than the angels, crowned with glory and honour because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for every one. For it was fitting that he, for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the pioneer of their salvation perfect through suffering. For he who sanctifies and those who are sanctified have all one origin. That is why he is not ashamed to call them brethren. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

Alleluia, alleluia! As long as we love one another God will live in us and his love will be complete in us. **Alleluia!** (1 Jn 4:12).

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Mark(10:2-16)

Some Pharisees came up and in order to test Jesus asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?" He answered them, "What did Moses command you?" They said, "Moses allowed a man to write a certificate of divorce, and to put her away." But Jesus said to them, "For your hardness of heart he wrote you this commandment. But from the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female.' 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one.' So they are no longer two but one. What therefore God has joined together, let not man put asunder." And in the house the disciples asked him again about this matter. And he said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another, commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery." And they were bringing children to him, that he might touch them; and the disciples rebuked them. But when Jesus saw it he was indignant, and said to them, "Let the children come to me, do not hinder them; for to such belongs the kingdom of God. Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it." And he took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands upon them. **The Gospel of the Lord.**

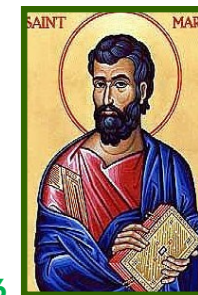

THE SACRAMENTS: Unite us in Christ.

(68) Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism"

229. Why are the sacraments efficacious? (1127-1128;1131) The sacraments are efficacious *ex opere operato* ("by the very fact that the sacramental action is performed") because it is Christ who acts in the sacraments and communicates the grace they signify. The efficacy of the sacraments does not depend upon the personal holiness of the minister. However, the fruits of the sacraments do depend on the dispositions of the one who receives them.

230. For what reason are the sacraments necessary for salvation? (1129) For believers in Christ the sacraments, even if they are not all given to each of the faithful, are necessary for salvation because they confer sacramental grace, forgiveness of sins, adoption as children of God, conformation to Christ the Lord and membership in the Church. The Holy Spirit heals and transforms those who receive the sacraments.

231. What is sacramental grace? (1129, 1131;1134, 2003) Sacramental grace is the grace of the Holy Spirit which is given by Christ and is proper to each sacrament. This grace helps the faithful in their journey toward holiness and so assists the Church as well to grow in charity and in her witness to the world.

357. How is the Christian life bound up with faith and the sacraments? (1691-1698) What the symbol of faith professes, the sacraments communicate. Indeed, through them the faithful receive the grace of Christ and the gifts of the Holy Spirit which give them the capability of living a new life as children of God in Christ whom they have received in faith. "O Christian, recognize your dignity." (Saint Leo the Great)

232. What is the relationship between the sacraments and everlasting life? (1130) In the sacraments the Church already receives a foretaste of eternal life, while "awaiting in blessed hope, the appearing in glory of our great God and saviour Christ.



I SACRAMENTI: Ci uniscono in Cristo.

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (68)

229. Perché i Sacramenti sono efficaci? (1127-1128;1131) I Sacramenti sono efficaci *ex opere operato* («per il fatto stesso che l'azione sacramentale viene compiuta»), perché è Cristo che agisce in essi e che comunica la grazia che significano, indipendentemente dalla santità personale del ministro. Tuttavia i frutti dei Sacramenti dipendono anche dalle disposizioni di chi li riceve.

230. Per quale motivo i Sacramenti sono necessari alla salvezza? (1129) Per i credenti in Cristo, i Sacramenti sono necessari alla salvezza, anche se non vengono dati tutti ad ogni singolo fedele, perché conferiscono le grazie sacramentali, il perdono dei peccati, l'adozione a figli di Dio, la conformazione a Cristo Signore e l'appartenenza alla Chiesa. Lo Spirito Santo guarisce e trasforma coloro che li ricevono.

231. Che cos'è la grazia sacramentale? (1129; 1131;1134; 2003) La grazia sacramentale è la grazia dello Spirito Santo, donata da Cristo e propria di ciascun Sacramento. Tale grazia aiuta il fedele nel suo cammino di santità, e così pure aiuta la Chiesa nella sua crescita di carità e di testimonianza.

357. Come la vita cristiana è legata alla fede e ai Sacramenti? (1691-1698) Ciò che il Simbolo della fede professa, i Sacramenti lo comunicano. Infatti, con essi i fedeli ricevono la grazia di Cristo e i doni dello Spirito Santo, che li rendono capaci di vivere la nuova vita di figli di Dio nel Cristo accolto con la fede. «Riconosci, o cristiano, la tua dignità» (San Leone Magno).

232. Qual è la relazione tra i Sacramenti e la vita eterna? (1130) Nei Sacramenti la Chiesa riceve già un anticipo della vita eterna, mentre resta «nell'attesa della beata speranza e della manifestazione della gloria del nostro grande Dio e Salvatore Gesù Cristo» (Tt 2,13).
