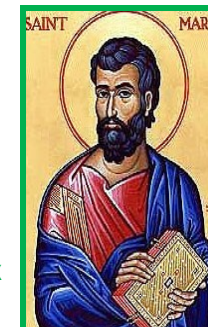

We thank and praise God for giving us a new **Saint John Baptist Scalabrini**, canonised today 9 October 2022 in Rome.

Let us ask his intercession that the Good Lord grant us the wisdom and courage to be able to assimilate the teachings of Jesus Christ into ways in which we live our lives. Saint John Baptist Scalabrini. Pray for us.

Biographical notes of Saint John Baptist Scalabrini

- Born and baptised the same day in Fino Mornasco (Como) on 8 July 1839.
 - Ordained priest on 30 May 1863; professor and rector of the St. Abbondio diocesan seminary.
 - In 1870 he named pastor of St. Bartholomew parish in Como.
 - Ordained bishop in Rome on 30 January 1876.
- Entry into the diocese of Piacenza on 13 February 1876.

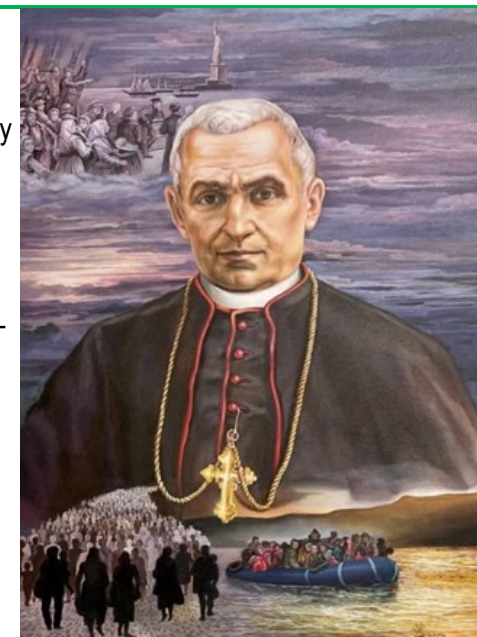
Bishop of Piacenza

- He did five pastoral visits to the 365 parishes of the diocese.
 - He celebrated three Synods: 1879, 1893, and 1899.
- He founded the School of Christian Doctrine; Pope Pius IX called him Apostle of the Catechism. Founded the catechetical review *il Catechista Cattolico*; held the first National Catechetical Congress in 1889.

Father to the migrants

- On 28 November 1887 he founded the Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Charles.
- In 1889 established the St. Raphael Lay Association for Assistance to Migrants.
- On 25 October 1895 he founded the Missionary Sisters of St. Charles.
- Visited his missionaries and their missions in the Americas: in 1901 in the US and in 1904 in Brazil.
- Died in Piacenza on 01 June 1905 (Solemnity of the Ascension).
- Beatified on 09 November 1997 by St Pope John Paul II
- Canonised on 9 October 2022 by Pope Francis

Note biografiche di San Giovanni Battista Scalabrini

- Nato e battezzato lo stesso giorno a Fino Mornasco (Como) l'8 luglio 1839.
- Ordinato sacerdote il 30 maggio 1863; professore e rettore del seminario diocesano S. Abbondio.
- Nel 1870 viene nominato parroco della parrocchia di S. Bartolomeo a Como.
- Ordinato vescovo a Roma il 30 gennaio 1876.
- Ingresso nella diocesi di Piacenza il 13 febbraio 1876.

Vescovo di Piacenza

- Ha compiuto cinque visite pastorali alle 365 parrocchie della diocesi.
- Ha celebrato tre Sinodi: 1879, 1893 e 1899.
- Fondò la Scuola di Dottrina Cristiana; Papa Pio IX lo chiamò Apostolo del Catechismo. Fondò la rivista catechistica *il Catechista Cattolico*; tenne il primo Congresso Catechistico Nazionale nel 1889.

Padre ai migranti

- Il 28 novembre 1887 fonda la Congregazione dei Missionari di S. Carlo.
- Nel 1889 fonda l'Associazione Laicale St. Raphael per l'assistenza ai migranti.
- Il 25 ottobre 1895 fonda le Suore Missionarie di S. Carlo.
- Visitò i suoi missionari e le loro missioni nelle Americhe: nel 1901 negli Stati Uniti e nel 1904 in Brasile.
- Muore a Piacenza il 1° giugno 1905 (Solemnità dell'Ascensione).
- Beatificato il 09 novembre 1997 da Papa Giovanni Paolo II
- Canonizzato il 9 ottobre 2022 da Papa Francesco
