At my first defence no one took my part; all deserted me. May it not be charged against them! But the Lord stood by me and gave me strength to proclaim the word fully, that all the Gentiles might hear it. So I was rescued from the lion's mouth. The Lord will rescue me from every evil and save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory for ever and ever. Amen.

The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank thee that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, I give tithes of all that I get.' But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who humbles himself will be exalted." **The Gospel of the Lord.**

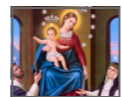

PRAYER IN THE CHRISTIAN LIFE

All times are good for prayer. The Church, however, proposes special times to the faithful to stress and nurture continual prayer: morning and evening prayer, prayers before and after meals, the liturgy of the hours, the Sunday Eucharist, the Rosary and the feasts of the Liturgical Year.

534. What is prayer? (2558-2565;2590) Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God, or the petition of good things from him in accord with his will. It is always the gift of God who comes to encounter man. Christian prayer is the personal and living relationship of the children of God with their Father who is infinitely good, with his Son Jesus Christ, and with the Holy Spirit who dwells in their hearts.

539. What is the role of prayer in the mission of the prophets? (2581-2584) The prophets drew from prayer the light and strength to exhort the people to faith and to conversion of heart. They entered into great intimacy with God and interceded for their brothers and sisters to whom they proclaimed what they had seen and heard from the Lord. Elijah was the father of the prophets, of those who sought the face of God. On Mount Carmel he achieved the return of the people to the faith, thanks to the intervention of God to whom he prayed: "Answer me, O Lord, answer me!" (1 Kings 18:37).

540. What is the importance of the Psalms in prayer? (2579;2585-2589;2596-2597) The Psalms are the summit of prayer in the Old Testament: the Word of God become the prayer of man. Inseparably both personal and communal, and inspired by the Holy Spirit, this prayer sings of God's marvelous deeds in creation and in the history of salvation. Christ prayed the Psalms and brought them to fulfillment. Thus they remain an essential and permanent element of the prayer of the Church suited to people of every condition and time.

PRAYER IS FULLY REVEALED AND REALIZED IN JESUS

541. From whom did Jesus learn how to pray? (2599;2620) Jesus, with his human heart, learned how to pray from his mother and from the Jewish tradition. But his prayer sprang from a more secret source because he is the eternal Son of God who in his holy humanity offers his perfect filial prayer to his Father.

542. When did Jesus pray? (2600-2604;2620) The Gospel often shows Jesus at prayer. We see him draw apart to pray in solitude, even at night. He prays before the decisive moments of his mission or that of his apostles. In fact, all his life is a prayer because he is in a constant communion of love with the Father.

534. Che cos'è la preghiera? (2558-2505;2590) La preghiera è l'elevazione dell'anima a Dio o la domanda a Dio di beni conformi alla sua volontà. Essa è sempre dono di Dio che viene ad incontrare l'uomo. La preghiera cristiana è relazione personale e viva dei figli di Dio con il loro Padre infinitamente buono, con il Figlio suo Gesù Cristo e con lo Spirito Santo che abita nel loro cuore.

539. Qual è il ruolo della preghiera nella missione dei profeti? (2581-2584) I profeti attingono dalla preghiera luce e forza per esortare il popolo alla fede e alla conversione del cuore. Entrano in una grande intimità con Dio e intercedono per i fratelli, ai quali annunciano quanto hanno visto e udito dal Signore. Elia è il padre dei profeti, di coloro cioè che cercano il Volto di Dio. Sul Monte Carmelo egli ottiene il ritorno del popolo alla fede grazie all'intervento di Dio, da lui supplicato così: «Rispondimi, Signore, rispondimi!» (1 Re 18,37).

540. Qual è l'importanza dei Salmi nella preghiera? (2579;2585-2589;2596-2597) I Salmi sono il vertice della preghiera nell'Antico Testamento: la Parola di Dio diventa preghiera dell'uomo. Inseparabilmente personale e comunitaria, questa preghiera, ispirata dallo Spirito Santo, canta le meraviglie di Dio nella creazione e nella storia della salvezza. Cristo ha pregato i Salmi e li ha portati a compimento. Per questo essi rimangono un elemento essenziale e permanente della preghiera della Chiesa, adatti agli uomini di ogni condizione e di ogni tempo.

LA PREGHIERA E' PIENAMENTE RIVELATA E ATTUATA IN GESU'

541. Da chi Gesù ha imparato a pregare? (2599;2620) Gesù, secondo il suo cuore di uomo, ha imparato a pregare da sua Madre e dalla tradizione ebraica. Ma la sua preghiera sgorga da una sorgente più segreta, poiché è il Figlio eterno di Dio che, nella sua santa umanità, rivolge a suo Padre la preghiera filiale perfetta.

542. Quando pregava Gesù? (2600-2604;2620) Il Vangelo mostra spesso Gesù in preghiera. Lo vediamo ritirarsi in solitudine, anche la notte. Prega prima dei momenti decisivi della sua missione o di quella degli Apostoli. Di fatto, tutta la sua vita è preghiera, poiché è in costante comunione d'amore con il Padre.
