

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Let my prayer come into your presence. Incline your heart to my cry for help, O Lord (Ps 88:2).

A reading from the First Book of the Kings (17:10-16) Elijah went to Zarephath; and when he came to the gate of the city, behold, a widow was there gathering sticks; and he called to her and said, "Bring me a little water in a vessel, that I may drink." And as she was going to bring it, he called to her and said, "Bring me a morsel of bread in your hand." And she said, "As the Lord your God lives, I have nothing baked, only a handful of meal in a jar, and a little oil in a cruse; and now, I am gathering a couple of sticks, that I may go in and prepare it for myself and my son, that we may eat it, and die." And Elijah said to her, "Fear not; go and do as you have said; but first make me a little cake of it and bring it to me, and afterward make for yourself and your son. For thus says the Lord the God of Israel, 'The jar of meal shall not be spent, and the cruse of oil shall not fail, until the day that the Lord sends rain upon the earth.'" And she went and did as Elijah said; and she, and he, and her household ate for many days. The jar of meal was not spent, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the Lord which he spoke by Elijah. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

He upholds the widow and orphan but thwarts the path of the wicked. The Lord will reign for ever, Zion's God, from age to age. **R./**

A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews(9:24-28)

Christ has entered, not into a sanctuary made with hands, a copy of the true one, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf. Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the Holy Place yearly with blood not his own; for then he would have had to suffer repeatedly since the foundation of the world. But as it is, he has appeared once for all at the end of the age to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself. And just as it is appointed for men to die once, and after that comes judgment, so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him.

This is the Word of the Lord.

Alleluia, alleluia! How happy are the poor in spirit; theirs is the kingdom of heaven. **Alleluia!** (Mt 5:3).

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Mark (12:38-44)

In his teaching Jesus said, "Beware of the scribes, who like to go about in long robes, and to have salutations in the market places and the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honour at feasts, who devour widows' houses and for a pretence make long prayers. They will receive the greater condemnation." And Jesus sat down opposite the treasury, and watched the multitude putting money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. And a poor widow came, and put in two copper coins, which make a penny. And he called his disciples to him, and said to them, "Truly, I say to you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the treasury. For they all contributed out of their abundance; but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, her whole living." **The Gospel of the Lord.**

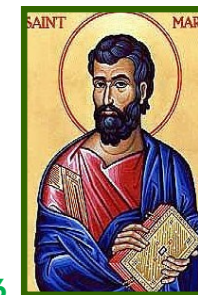

The Ten Commandments

(72) Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism"

1. I am the LORD your God: you shall not have strange Gods before me.
2. You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the LORD'S day.
4. Honor your father and your mother.
5. You shall not kill.
6. You shall not commit adultery.
7. You shall not steal.
8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

436. What does "Decalogue" mean? (2056-2057) Decalogue means "ten words" (Exodus 34:28). These words sum up the Law given by God to the people of Israel in the context of the Covenant mediated by Moses. This Decalogue, in presenting the commandments of the love of God (the first three) and of one's neighbour (the other seven), traces for the chosen people and for every person in particular the path to a life freed from the slavery of sin.

437. What is the bond between the Decalogue and the Covenant? (2058-2063; 2077) The Decalogue must be understood in the light of the Covenant in which God revealed himself and made known his will. In observing the commandments, the people manifested their belonging to God and they answered his initiative of love with thanksgiving.

439. Why does the Decalogue constitute an organic unity? (2069; 2079) The Ten Commandments form an organic and indivisible whole because each commandment refers to the other commandments and to the entire Decalogue. To break one commandment, therefore, is to violate the entire law.

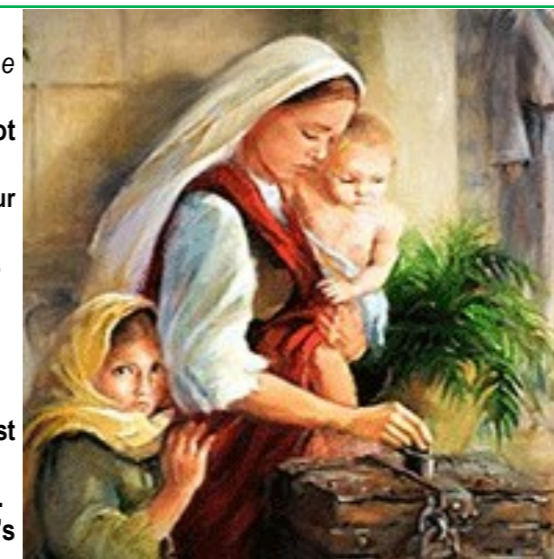
434. Is the observance of the Ten Commandments necessary for eternal life? (2052-2054; 2075-2076) To the young man who asked the question: "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?", Jesus answered, "If you would enter into life, keep the commandments", and then he added, "Come, follow Me" (Matthew 19:16-21). To follow Jesus involves keeping the commandments. The law has not been abolished but man is invited to rediscover it in the Person of the divine Master who realized it perfectly in himself, revealed its full meaning and attested to its permanent validity

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (72)

436. Che cosa significa «Decalogo»?

(2056-2057) Decalogo significa «dieci parole» (Es 34,28). Queste parole riassumono la Legge donata da Dio al popolo d'Israele nel contesto dell'Alleanza mediante Mosè. Esso, nel presentare i Comandamenti dell'amore di Dio (i primi tre) e del prossimo (gli altri sette), traccia, per il popolo eletto e per ciascuno in particolare, il cammino di una vita liberata dalla schiavitù del peccato.

437. Qual è il legame del Decalogo con l'Alleanza? (2058-2063; 2077) Il Decalogo si comprende alla luce dell'Alleanza, nella quale Dio si rivela, facendo conoscere la sua volontà. Nell'osservare i Comandamenti, il popolo esprime la propria appartenenza a Dio e risponde con gratitudine alla sua iniziativa d'amore.

439. Perché il Decalogo costituisce un'unità organica? (2069; 2079) I dieci Comandamenti costituiscono un insieme organico e indissociabile, perché ogni Comandamento rimanda agli altri e a tutto il Decalogo. Perciò trasgredire un Comandamento è infrangere l'intera Legge.

434. «Maestro, che cosa devo fare di buono per ottenere la vita eterna?» (Mt 19,16) (2052-2054; 2075-2076) Al giovane che gli rivolge questa domanda Gesù risponde: «Se vuoi entrare nella vita, osserva i Comandamenti», e poi aggiunge: «Vieni e seguimi» (Mt 19,16.21). Seguire Gesù implica l'osservanza dei Comandamenti. La Legge non è abolita, ma l'uomo è invitato a ritrovarla nella persona del divino Maestro, che la realizza perfettamente in se stesso, ne rivela il pieno significato e ne attesta la perennità.
