A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews (10:11-14, 18) Every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, then to wait until his enemies should be made a stool for his feet. For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are sanctified. Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no longer any offering for sin. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

Alleluia, alleluia! Stay awake, pray at all time, for the strength to stand with confidence before the Son of Man. **Alleluia!** (Lk 21:36)

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Mark (13:24-32) Jesus said to his disciples, "In those days, after the great tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of man coming in clouds with great power and glory. And then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven. "From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts forth its leaves you know that summer is near. So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that he is near, at the very gates. Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away before all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away. "But of that day or that hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father." **The Gospel of the Lord.**

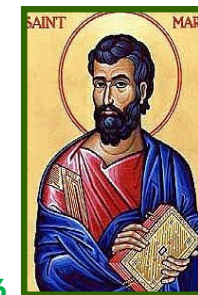

The Ten Commandments

(73) Serialised presentation of the "Compendium of the Catechism"

435. How did Jesus interpret the Law?

(2055) Jesus interpreted the Law in the light of the twofold yet single commandment of love, the fullness of the Law: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the greatest and first commandment. And the second is like it: you shall love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets" (Matthew 22:37-40).

438. What importance does the Church give to the Decalogue? (2064-2068) The Church, in fidelity to Scripture and to the example of Christ, acknowledges the primordial importance and significance of the Decalogue. Christians are obliged to keep it.

440. Why does the Decalogue enjoin serious obligations? (2072-2073; 2081) It does so because the Decalogue expresses the fundamental duties of man towards God and towards his neighbor.

441. Is it possible to keep the Decalogue? (2074; 2082) Yes, because Christ without whom we can do nothing enables us to keep it with the gift of his Spirit and his grace.

THE 1st COMMANDMENT: I am the Lord your God, you shall not have other gods before me. It is also written in Scriptures: "You Shall Love the Lord Your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind".

442. What is implied in the affirmation of God: "I am the Lord your God" (Exodus 20:2)?

(2083-2094; 2133-2134) This means that the faithful must guard and activate the three theological virtues and must avoid sins which are opposed to them. *Faith* believes in God and rejects everything that is opposed to it, such as, deliberate doubt, unbelief, heresy, apostasy, and schism. *Hope* trustingly awaits the blessed vision of God and his help, while avoiding despair and presumption. *Charity* loves God above all things and therefore repudiates indifference, ingratitude, lukewarmness, sloth or spiritual indolence, and that hatred of God which is born of pride.

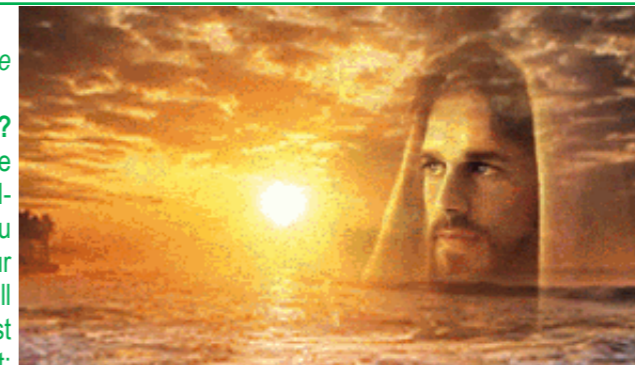
443. What is the meaning of the words of our Lord, "Adore the Lord your God and worship Him alone" (Matthew 4:10)? (2095-2105; 2135-2136) These words mean to adore God as the Lord of everything that exists; to render to him the individual and community worship which is his due; to pray to him with sentiments of praise, of thanks, and of supplication; to offer him sacrifices, above all the spiritual sacrifice of one's own life, united with the perfect sacrifice of Christ; and to keep the promises and vows made to him.

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (73)

435. Come Gesù interpreta la Legge? (2055) Gesù la interpreta alla luce del duplice e unico Comandamento della carità, pienezza della Legge: «Amerai il Signore Dio tuo con tutto il tuo cuore, con tutta la tua anima e con tutta la tua mente. Questo è il più grande e il primo dei Comandamenti. E il secondo è simi-

le al primo: Amerai il prossimo tuo come te stesso. Da questi due Comandamenti dipende tutta la Legge e i Profeti» (Mt 22,37-40).

438. Quale importanza dà la Chiesa al Decalogo? (2064-2068) Fedele alla Scrittura e all'esempio di Gesù, la Chiesa riconosce al Decalogo un'importanza e un significato basilari. I cristiani sono obbligati ad osservarlo.

440. Perché il Decalogo obbliga gravemente? (2072-2073;2081) Perché enuncia i doveri fondamentali dell'uomo verso Dio e verso il prossimo.

441. È possibile osservare il Decalogo? (2074; 2082) Sì, perché Cristo, senza il quale nulla possiamo fare, ci rende capaci di osservarlo, con il dono del suo Spirito e della sua grazia.

IL 1.mo COMANDAMENTO: Io sono il Signore Dio tuo. Non avrai altro dio fuori di me.

Nella Scrittura leggiamo: "Amerai il Signore tuo Dio con tutto il tuo cuore, con tutta la tua anima e con tutta la tua mente".

442. Che cosa implica l'affermazione di Dio: «Io sono il Signore Dio tuo» (Es 20,2)? (2083-2094; 2133-2134) Implica per il fedele di custodire e attuare le tre virtù teologali e di evitare i peccati che vi si oppongono. *La fede* crede in Dio e respinge ciò che le è contrario, come ad esempio, il dubbio volontario, l'incredulità, l'eresia, l'apostasia, lo scisma. *La speranza* attende fiduciosamente la beata visione di Dio e il suo aiuto, evitando la disperazione e la presunzione. *La carità* ama Dio al di sopra di tutto: vanno dunque respinte l'indifferenza, l'ingratitude, la tiepidezza, l'accidia o indolenza spirituale, e l'odio di Dio, che nasce dall'orgoglio.

443. Che cosa comporta la Parola del Signore: «Adora il Signore Dio tuo e a lui solo rendi culto» (Mt 4,10)? (2095-2105; 2135-2136) Essa comporta: adorare Dio come Signore di tutto ciò che esiste; rendergli il culto dovuto individualmente e comunitariamente; pregarlo con espressioni di lode, di ringraziamento e di supplica; offrirgli sacrifici, soprattutto quello spirituale della propria vita, in unione con il sacrificio perfetto di Cristo; mantenere le promesse e i voti a Lui fatti.
