4TH SUNDAY OF EASTER. The Church is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.

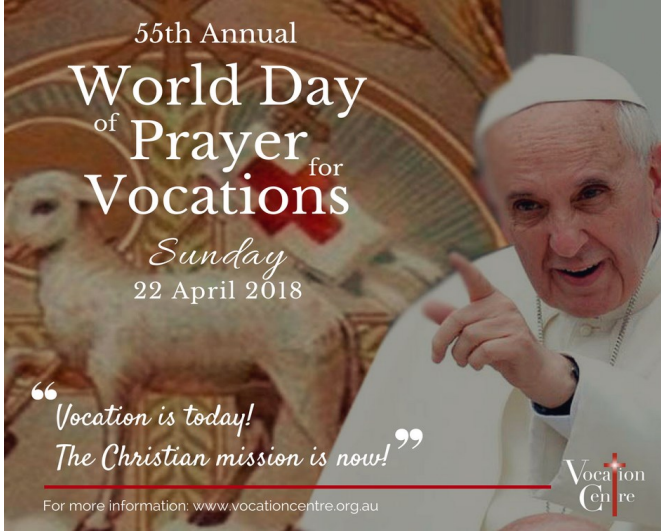
161. Why is the Church one? (813-815;866) The Church is one because she has as her source and exemplar the unity of the Trinity of Persons in one God. As her Founder and Head, Jesus Christ re-established the unity of all people in one body. As her soul, the Holy Spirit unites all the faithful in communion with Christ. The Church has but one faith, one sacramental life, one apostolic succession, one common hope, and one and the same charity.

162. Where does the one Church of Christ subsist? (816;870) The one Church of Christ, as a society constituted and organized in the world, subsists in (*subsistit in*) the Catholic Church, governed by the Successor of Peter and the bishops in communion with him. Only through this Church can one obtain the fullness of the means of salvation since the Lord has entrusted all the blessings of the New Covenant to the apostolic college alone whose head is Peter.

163. How are non-Catholic Christians to be considered? (817-819;870) In the churches and ecclesial communities which are separated from full communion with the Catholic Church, many elements of sanctification and truth can be found. All of these blessings come from Christ and lead to Catholic unity. Members of these churches and communities are incorporated into Christ by Baptism and we so we recognize them as brothers.

164. How does one commit oneself to work for the unity of Christians? (820-822;866) The desire to restore the unity of all Christians is a gift from Christ and a call of the Spirit. This desire involves the entire Church and it is pursued by conversion of heart, prayer, fraternal knowledge of each other and theological dialogue.

165. In what way is the Church holy? (823-829; 867) The Church is holy insofar as the Most Holy God is her author. Christ has given himself for her to sanctify her and make her a source of sanctification. The Holy Spirit gives her life with charity. In the Church one finds the fullness of the means of salvation. Holiness is the vocation of each of her members and the purpose of all her activities. The Church counts among her members the Virgin Mary and numerous Saints who are her models and intercessors. The holiness of the Church is the fountain of sanctification for her children who here on earth recognize themselves as sinners ever in need of conversion and purification.

Dal Compendio del Catechismo (44)

161. Perché la Chiesa è una? (813-815;866) La Chiesa è una perché ha come origine e modello l'unità di un solo Dio nella Trinità delle Persone; come fondatore e capo Gesù Cristo, che ristabilisce l'unità di tutti i popoli in un solo corpo; come anima lo Spirito Santo, che unisce tutti i fedeli nella Comunione in Cristo. Essa ha una sola fede, una sola vita sacramen-

tale, un'unica successione apostolica, una comune speranza e la stessa carità.

162. Dove sussiste l'unica Chiesa di Cristo? (816;870) L'unica Chiesa di Cristo, come società costituita e organizzata nel mondo, sussiste (*subsistit in*) nella Chiesa cattolica, governata dal successore di Pietro e dai Vescovi in comunione con lui. Solo per mezzo di essa si può ottenere la pienezza dei mezzi di salvezza, poiché il Signore ha affidato tutti i beni della Nuova Alleanza al solo collegio apostolico, il cui capo è Pietro.

163. Come considerare i cristiani non cattolici? (817-819) Nelle Chiese e comunità ecclesiali, che si sono staccate dalla piena comunione della Chiesa cattolica, si trovano molti elementi di santificazione e di verità. Tutti questi beni provengono da Cristo e spingono verso l'unità cattolica. I membri di queste Chiese e Comunità sono incorporati a Cristo nel Battesimo: noi li riconosciamo perciò come fratelli.

164. Come impegnarsi a favore dell'unità dei cristiani? (820-822;866) Il desiderio di ristabilire l'unione di tutti i cristiani è un dono di Cristo e un appello dello Spirito. Esso riguarda tutta la Chiesa e si attua con la conversione del cuore, la preghiera, la reciproca conoscenza fraterna, il dialogo teologico.





165. In che senso la Chiesa è santa? (823-829) La Chiesa è santa, in quanto Dio Santissimo è il suo autore; Cristo ha dato se stesso per lei, per santificarla e renderla santificante; lo Spirito Santo la vivifica con la carità. In essa si trova la pienezza dei mezzi di salvezza. La santità è la vocazione di ogni suo membro e il fine di ogni sua attività. La Chiesa annovera al suo interno la Vergine Maria e innumerevoli Santi, quali modelli e intercessori. La santità della Chiesa è la sorgente della santificazione dei suoi figli, i quali, qui sulla terra, si riconoscono tutti peccatori, sempre bisognosi di conversione e di purificazione.
