

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: The merciful love of the Lord fills the earth; by the word of the Lord the heavens were made, alleluia. (Ps 32:5-6)

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (13:14,43-52)

Paul and Barnabas passed on from Perga and came to Antioch of Pisidia. And on the Sabbath day they went into the synagogue and sat down. When the meeting of the synagogue broke up, many Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who spoke to them and urged them to continue in the grace of God. The next sabbath almost the whole city gathered together to hear the word of God. But when the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with jealousy, and contradicted what was spoken by Paul, and reviled him. And Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God should be spoken first to you. Since you thrust it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we turn to the Gentiles. For so the Lord has commanded us, saying, I have set you to be a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the uttermost parts of the earth'." And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and glorified the word of God; and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed. And the word of the Lord spread throughout all the region. But the Jews incited the devout women of high standing and the leading men of the city, and stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of their district. But they shook off the dust from their feet against them, and went to Iconium. And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit. This is the Word of the Lord.

They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; the sun shall not strike them, nor any scorching heat. For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water; and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."This is the Word of the Lord.



THE SEVENTH COMMANDMENT:

"You shall not steal" (continue)

515. What responsibility does the State have in regard to labor? (2431) It is the role of the State to quarantee individual freedom and private property. as well as a stable currency and efficient public services. It is also the State's responsibility to oversee and direct the exercise of human rights in the economic sector. According to circumstances, societv must help citizens to find work.

516. What is the task of business management? (2432) Business managers are responsible for the economic and ecological effects of their operations. They must consider the good of persons and not only the increase of profits, even though profits are necessary to assure investments, the future of the business, employment, and the good progress of economic life. 517. What are the duties of work-

ers? (2435) They must carry out their work in a conscientious way with competence and dedication, seeking to resolve any controversies with dialogue. Recourse to a non-violent strike is morally legitimate when it appears to be the necessary way to obtain a proportionate benefit and it takes into account the common good.

518. How is justice and solidarity among nations brought about? 518. Come si attua la giustizia e la solidarietà tra le nazioni? (2437-(2437-2441) On the international level, all nations and institutions must carry out their work in solidarity and subsidiarity for the purpose of eliminating or at least reducing poverty, the inequality of resources and economic potential, economic and social injustices, the exploitation of persons, the accumulation of debts by poor countries, and the perverse mechanisms that impede the development of the less advanced countries.

519. In what way do Christians participate in political and social life? (2442) The lay faithful take part directly in political and social life by animating temporal realities with a Christian spirit and collaborating with all as authentic witnesses of the Gospel and agents of peace and justice. **520.** By what is love for the poor inspired? (2443-2449;2462-2463) Love for the poor is inspired by the Gospel of the Beatitudes and by the example of Jesus in his constant concern for the poor. Jesus said, "Whatever you have done to the least of my brethren, you have done to me" (Matthew 25:40). Love for the poor shows itself through the struggle against material poverty and also against the many forms of cultural, moral, and religious poverty. The spiritual and corporal works of mercy and the many charitable institutions formed throughout the centuries are a concrete witness to the preferential love for the poor which characterizes the disciples of Jesus.

IL SETTIMO COMANDAMENTO: "Non Rubare" (continua)

515. Qual è la responsabilità dello Stato circa il lavoro? (2431) Allo Stato spetta di procurare la sicurezza circa le garanzie delle libertà individuali e della proprietà, oltre che una moneta stabile e servizi pubblici efficienti: di sorvegliare e guidare l'esercizio dei diritti umani nel settore economico. In rapporto alle circostanze, la società deve aiutare i cittadini a trovare lavoro.

516. Quale compito hanno i dirigenti di imprese? (2432) I dirigenti di imprese hanno la responsabilità economica ed ecologica delle loro operazioni. Devono considerare il bene delle persone e non soltanto l'aumento dei profitti, anche se questi sono necessari per assicurare gli investimenti, l'avvenire delle imprese. l'occupazione e il buon andamento della vita economica.

517. Quali doveri hanno i lavoratori? (2435) Essi devono compiere il loro lavoro con coscienza, competenza e dedizione, cercando di risolvere le eventuali controversie con il dialogo. Il ricorso allo sciopero non violento è moralmente legittimo quando appare come lo strumento necessario, in vista di un vantaggio proporzionato e tenendo conto del bene comune.

2441) A livello internazionale, tutte le nazioni e le istituzioni devono operare nella solidarietà e sussidiarietà, al fine di eliminare o almeno ridurre la miseria, la disuguaglianza delle risorse e dei mezzi economici, le ingiustizie economiche e sociali, lo sfruttamento delle persone, l'accumulo dei debiti dei paesi poveri, i meccanismi perversi che ostacolano lo sviluppo dei paesi meno progrediti.

519. In che modo i cristiani partecipano alla vita politica e sociale? (2442) I fedeli laici intervengono direttamente nella vita politica e sociale, animando, con spirito cristiano, le realtà temporali e collaborando con tutti, da autentici testimoni del Vangelo e operatori di pace e di giustizia. **520.** A che cosa si ispira l'amore per i poveri? (2443-2449;2462-2463) L'amore per i poveri si ispira al Vangelo delle beatitudini e all'esempio di Gesù nella sua costante attenzione per i poveri. Gesù ha detto: «Ogni volta che avete fatto queste cose a uno solo di guesti fratelli più piccoli, l'avete fatto a me» (Mt 25,40). L'amore per i poveri si attua attraverso l'impegno contro la povertà materiale e anche contro le numerose forme di povertà culturale, morale e religiosa.
