
LOURDES DAY MASS SATURDAY 10 FEBRUARY 2024

cially inaugurated the Year of Prayer ahead of the 2025 Jubilee. In comments after the Sunday Angelus, Pope Francis spoke about our need of 'rediscovering the great value and absolute need for prayer, prayer in personal life, in the life of the Church, prayer in the world.' The jubilee year begins on 24 December 2024 and extends until 6 January 2026. A special year of grace and pilgrimage The Holy Doors of St Peter's Basilica and other major basilicas in Rome, usually locked from the inside, are opened for a jubilee year and any who pass through can receive a plenary indulgence (with all the usual conditions).
