Far from relying on any power of my own, I came among you in great 'fear and trembling' and in my speeches and the sermons that I gave, there were none of the arguments that belong to philosophy; only a demonstration of the power of the Spirit. And I did this so that your faith should not depend on human philosophy but on the power of God The Word of the Lord.



To appreciate this, we must recall the setting in which the Sermon takes place: the mass of burdened, afflicted humanity described as the recipients of Jesus' healing at the end of the preceding chapter (4:23-25). Matthew's introduction to the Sermon (5:1-2) suggests that it is the sight of these crowds and their needs that prompts Jesus to address his disciples in the way that follows ('Seeing the crowds, he went up the mountain ...'). The implication is that it is people who are prepared to live according to the dispositions and attitudes pronounce 'blessed' in the Beatitudes (vv. 3-12) – that is, people prepared to live in the vulnerable, non-grasping way they propose - who can really help lift humanity's burdens, thereby becoming and remaining 'salt of the earth' and 'light of the world'. It is the compassionate and merciful who make the world safe for humanity. (Paul's description in the Second Reading of the vulnerable way in which he approached the community in Corinth illustrates this disposition). In this way the community that is receiving from Jesus the 'Torah' for the messianic age will reclaiming the vocation of Israel as spelled out in the passages from Isaiah.






