6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER. The Church is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.
 (46) *Serialised presentation of the :Compendium of the Catechism".*
171. What is the meaning of the affirmation "Outside the Church there is no salvation"? (846-848) This means that all salvation comes from Christ, the Head, through the Church which is his body. Hence they cannot be saved who, knowing the Church as founded by Christ and necessary for salvation, would refuse to enter her or remain in her. At the same time, thanks to Christ and to his Church, those who through no fault of their own do not know the Gospel of Christ and his Church but sincerely seek God and, moved by grace, try to do his will as it is known through the dictates of conscience can attain eternal salvation.
172. Why must the Church proclaim the Gospel to the whole world? (849-851) The Church must do so because Christ has given the command: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19). This missionary mandate of the Lord has its origin in the eternal love of God who has sent his Son and the Holy Spirit because "he desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4).
173. In what sense is the Church missionary? (852-856) The Church, guided by the Holy Spirit, continues the mission of Christ himself in the course of history. Christians must, therefore, proclaim to everyone the Good News borne by Christ; and, following his path, they must be ready for self-sacrifice, even unto martyrdom.
174. Why is the Church apostolic? (857;869) The Church is apostolic in her *origin* because she has been built on "the foundation of the Apostles" (Ephesians 2:20). She is apostolic in her *teaching* which is the same as that of the Apostles. She is apostolic by reason of her *structure* insofar as she is taught, sanctified, and guided until Christ returns by the Apostles through their successors who are the bishops in communion with the successor of Peter.
175. In what does the mission of the Apostles consist? (858-861) The Word "Apostle" means "one who is sent". Jesus, the One sent by the Father, called to himself twelve of his disciples and appointed them as his Apostles, making them the chosen witnesses of his Resurrection and the foundation of his Church. He gave them the command to continue his own mission saying, "As the Father has sent me, so I also send you" (John 20:21); and he promised to remain with them until the end of the world.
176. What is apostolic succession? (861-865) Apostolic succession is the transmission by means of the sacrament of Holy Orders of the mission and power of the Apostles to their successors, the bishops. Thanks to this transmission the Church remains in communion of faith and life with her origin, while through the centuries she carries on her apostolate for the spread of the Kingdom of Christ on earth.



SESTA DOMENICA DI PASQUA. La Chiesa è una, santa, cattolica e apostolica
 Dal Compendio del Catechismo (46)
171. Che cosa significa l'affermazione: «Fuori della Chiesa non c'è salvezza»? (846-848) Essa significa che ogni salvezza viene da Cristo-Capo per mezzo della Chiesa, che è il suo Corpo. Pertanto non possono essere salvati quanti, conoscendo la Chiesa come fondata da Cristo e necessaria alla salvezza, non vi entrarono e non vi perseverarono. Nello stesso tempo, grazie a Cristo e alla sua Chiesa, possono conseguire la salvezza eterna quanti, senza loro colpa, ignorano il Vangelo di Cristo e la sua Chiesa, ma cercano sinceramente Dio e, sotto l'influsso della grazia, si sforzano di compiere la sua volontà conosciuta attraverso il dettame della coscienza.
172. Perché la Chiesa deve annunciare il Vangelo a tutto il mondo? (849-851) Perché Cristo ha ordinato: «Andate dunque e ammaestrate tutte le nazioni, battezzandole nel nome del Padre, del Figlio e dello Spirito Santo» (Mt 28,19). Questo mandato missionario del Signore ha la sua sorgente nell'amore eterno di Dio, che ha inviato il suo Figlio e il suo Spirito perché «vuole che tutti gli uomini siano salvati e giungano alla conoscenza della verità» (1 Tm 2,4).
173. In che modo la Chiesa è missionaria? (852-856) Guidata dallo Spirito Santo, la Chiesa continua nel corso della storia la missione di Cristo stesso. I cristiani pertanto devono annunciare a tutti la Buona Novella portata da Cristo, seguendo la sua strada, disposti anche al sacrificio di sé fino al martirio.
174. Perché la Chiesa è apostolica? (857;869) La Chiesa è apostolica per la sua *origine*, essendo costruita sul « fondamento degli Apostoli» (Ef 2,20); per il suo *insegnamento*, che è quello stesso degli Apostoli; per la sua *struttura*, in quanto istruita, santificata e governata, fino al ritorno di Cristo, dagli Apostoli, grazie ai loro successori, i Vescovi, in comunione col successore di Pietro.
175. In che cosa consiste la missione degli Apostoli? (858-861) La parola *Apostolo* significa inviato. Gesù, l'Inviato del Padre, chiamò a sé dodici fra i suoi discepoli e li costituì come suoi Apostoli, facendo di loro i testimoni scelti della sua risurrezione e le fondamenta della sua Chiesa. Diede loro il mandato di continuare la sua missione, dicendo: «Come il Padre ha mandato me, anch'io mando voi» (Gv 20,21), e promettendo di essere con loro sino alla fine del mondo.
176. Che cos'è la successione apostolica? (861-865) La successione apostolica è la trasmissione, mediante il Sacramento dell'Ordine, della missione e della potestà degli Apostoli ai loro successori, i Vescovi. Grazie a questa trasmissione, la Chiesa rimane in comunione di fede e di vita con la sua origine, mentre lungo i secoli ordina, per la diffusione del Regno di Cristo sulla terra, tutto il suo apostolato.
