Peter then came out with the other disciple, and they went toward the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first; and stooping to look in, he saw the linen cloths lying there, but he did not go in. Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb; he saw the linen cloths lying, and the napkin, which had been on his head, not lying with the linen cloths but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple, who reached the tomb first, also went in, and he saw and believed; for as yet they did not know the scripture, that he must rise from the dead. **The Gospel of the Lord.**



EASTER SUNDAY

"Truly, Christ is risen and he appeared to Simon Peter" (Lk. 24:34)

Two Disciples of Jesus came running back from Emmaus to Jerusalem and with a heavy breath were about to announce that they had seen the Lord resurrected – but before they could speak they were met by the shout of the other Disciples: "Truly, Christ is risen and he appeared to Simon Peter" (Lk. 24: 34). Then Jesus himself appeared to all of them gathered in the upper-room, saying: "Peace be with you!" The resurrection of Jesus is an historical event proven by the empty tomb and the testimony of all the Apostles, the Disciples of Jesus and more than 500 people as testified in the Gospels, The Acts of the Apostles and the several Apostolic Letters that speak of the various encounters with Jesus following his resurrection. Up to the moment of the crucifixion and death of Jesus on the cross, the history of Israel was

in a state of expectation that God would, one day, send the Messiah, but could not believe it was Jesus; mankind was dominated by sin and moral darkness in the pagan world. **The resurrection of Jesus is the turning point in history:** Now to believe in Jesus is to believe that he is truly the Messiah and the Saviour of the whole world. It is, also, the turning point for the Apostles who, strengthened, then, by the Holy Spirit, boldly started to announce Jesus resurrected as the Saviour, the Baptism for conversion and the gathering of believers into a new community – the Church – not identified any longer with the Jewish people. The teaching of Jesus, preached by the Apostles and later gathered into the gospels, the celebration of Jesus present in the community as they gathered in prayer and the Eucharist, the living in love and harmony with all

(Act 2: 42), became essential moment of unity with the living Jesus that would transform their lives into witnesses of a new way of living by the Spirit of Christ. After his resurrection, Jesus said to the Apostles: "I am with you always till the end of time" (Mt.28: 20) This was the faith and the strength that animated the believers even to the point of martyrdom. This has been the faith and strength that has animated generations of believers from the time of the Apostles till today. Today Jesus is alive and continuing his mission to make our Imperfect and often sinful life "resurrect" with him to transform us into "more spiritual people" and leave behind "our life pleasing the flesh" (Gal. 5:16). The witnessing of this new life in the Spirit of Christ and by his power is offering a continuous hope to the world that it too can "resurrect" into a more truthful and loving society.

DOMENICA DI PASQUA

"Veramente Cristo è risorto ed è apparso a Simon Pietro" (Lc. 24:34)

Due discepoli di Gesù ritornarono velocemente da Emmaus a Gerusalemme e con il fiato pesante stavano per annunciare ai compagni che avevano visto Cristo risorto – ma prima che potessero parlare, gli altri discepoli gridarono con esultanza: "Veramente Cristo è risorto ed è apparso a Simone" (Lc. 24:34).

Poi Gesù stesso apparse a tutti riuniti nel Cenacolo dicendo: "Pace a voi!". La risurrezione di Gesù è un fatto storico provato dalla tomba vuota e la testimonianza degli Apostoli, i discepoli di Gesù e da oltre 500 persone, come viene testimoniato dai Vangeli, dagli Atti degli Apostoli, e dalle Lettere Apostoliche che parlano dei vari incontri con Gesù dopo la sua risurrezione. Fino al momento della crucifixione e morte di Gesù in croce, la storia d'Israele era in attesa del Messia che doveva venire, ma non credettero che Gesù era il Messia. L'umanità intera viveva sotto il peso del peccato e il buio morale in un mondo pagano. La risurrezione di Gesù cambia la storia dell'umanità. Ora, credere in Gesù è credere che lui è il Messia e il Salvatore per tutti. Questo porta anche un cambiamento profondo negli Apostoli che, ricevendo lo Spirito Santo, diventano coraggiosi nell'annunciare con forza che Cristo risorto è il Salvatore, il Battesimo della conversione dai peccati e nel raccogliere i fedeli in una comunità nuova – la Chiesa – che non si identifica più con i Giudei della sinagoga. Gli insegnamenti di Gesù vengono raccolti nei Vangeli, la comunità dei fedeli si riunisce a celebrare Cristo vivo in preghiera e la Celebrazione dell'Eucarestia e nel vivere nella pace e condivisione dei beni (Att. 2:42). In questa unione con Cristo vivo e tra loro essi davano testimonianza di una vita trasformata nello Spirito di Cristo. Prima di ascendere al cielo Gesù promise: "Io sarò con voi per sempre fino alla fine del mondo" (Mt. 28:20). Questa era la fede e la forza che animava i fedeli fino anche al punto del martirio. Questa fu la fede vissuta con forza e coraggio da tutte le generazioni dal tempo degli Apostoli fino al giorno d'oggi nella Chiesa. Oggi, Gesù vive e continua la sua missione di far "risorgere" questo nostro mondo imperfetto e ancora immerso nel peccato, invitandoci a "vivere nello spirito" e non soggetti ai desideri della carne" (Gal. 5:16). La nostra testimonianza di questa nuova vita vissuta nello Spirito di Cristo e per la sua grazia diventa "speranza di risurrezione" per il mondo intero dal male ad una società più giusta e buona. **A tutti voi, di cuore, una Buona e Santa Pasqua!**


