God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. This is the Word of the Lord.

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Mark (13:33-37) Jesus said to his disciples: "Be on your guard, stay awake; because you do not know when the time will come. Watch therefore - because you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or at cockcrow, or in the morning - lest he come suddenly and find you asleep. And what I say to you I say to all: stay awake!" The Gospel of the Lord.


