Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. This is the Word of the Lord.



The exuberance of the crowds in welcoming Christ into Jerusalem soon turns into rejection because human nature, un-aided by grace, can easily deceive us into accepting evil and reject goodness. Jesus, whom our sins rejected (the suffering servant in the 1st reading), shows us the way to redemption by faithfulness to God's will. In entering into our human experience, He humbled himself even onto death on the cross. For this reason God greatly exalted him above all others (2nd reading). The reading of the Passion of our Lord brings us
