A reading from the Letter of St Paul to the Philippians (3:8-14)

I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as refuse, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own, based on law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith; that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, that if possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead. Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brethren, I do not consider that I have made it my own; but one thing I do, forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. *This is the Word of the Lord.*

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St John (8:1-11)

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. Early in the morning he came again to the temple; all the people came to him, and he sat down and taught them. The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery, and placing her in the midst they said to him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in the act of adultery. Now in the law Moses commanded us to stone such. What do you say about her?" This they said to test him, that they might have some charge to bring against him. Jesus bent down and wrote with his finger on the ground. And as they continued to ask him, he stood up and said to them, "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her." And once more he bent down and wrote with his finger on the ground. But when they heard it, they went away, one by one, beginning with the eldest, and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before him. Jesus looked up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you: go, and do not sin again." *The Gospel of the Lord.*

**LENT 2019 5th Sunday of Lent:** "Woman, neither do I condemn you; but go and sin no more!"

The Scribes and Pharisees were ready to stone to death the woman caught in the very act of adultery – fulfilling Moses' order and according to the Law. The answer of Jesus, however, caught them off guard: "If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her". God's judgment of us goes much deeper than executing a law: he wants us all to recognise our sinfulness and repent from it and be healed in our relationship more through humility than self-righteousness. Sternly, he tells the woman: "Go forgiven, but don't sin any more". The Scribes

and the Pharisees also dispersed but very much conscious that they too are sinners in need of forgiveness. We pray: Lord, you know me deeply. I also need your forgiveness.

**THE SEVENTH COMMANDMENT: "YOU SHALL NOT STEAL"**

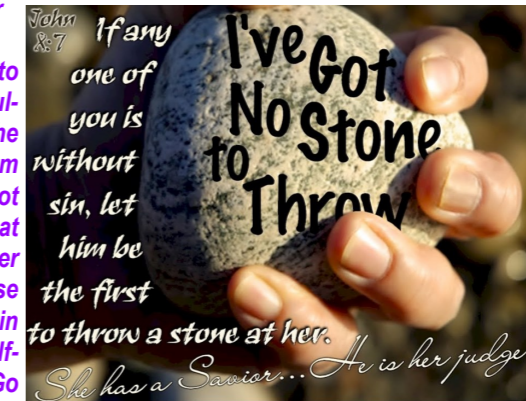
**503. What is set forth by the seventh commandment?** (2401-2402) The seventh commandment requires respect for the universal destination and distribution of goods and the private ownership of them, as well as respect for persons, their property, and the integrity of creation. The Church also finds in this Commandment the basis for her social doctrine which involves the correct way of acting in economic, social and political life, the right and the duty of human labor, justice and solidarity among nations, and love for the poor.

**504. Under what conditions does the right to private property exist?** (2403) The right to private property exists provided the property is acquired or received in a just way and that the universal destination of goods for the satisfaction of the basic needs of all takes precedence.

**505. What is the purpose of private property?** (2404-2406) The purpose of private property is to guarantee the freedom and dignity of individual persons by helping them to meet the basic needs of those in their charge and also of others who are in need.

**506. What does the seventh commandment require?** (2407;2450-2451) The seventh commandment requires respect for the goods of others through the practice of justice and charity, temperance and solidarity. In particular it requires respect for promises made and contracts agreed to, reparation for injustice committed and restitution of stolen goods, and respect for the integrity of creation by the prudent and moderate use of the mineral, vegetable, and animal resources of the universe with special attention to those species which are in danger of extinction.

**508. What is forbidden by the seventh commandment?** (2408-2413;2453-2455) Above all, the seventh commandment forbids theft, which is the taking or using of another's property against the reasonable will of the owner. This can be done also by paying unjust wages; by speculation on the value of goods in order to gain an advantage to the detriment of others; or by the forgery of checks or invoices. Also forbidden is tax evasion or business fraud; willfully damaging private or public property; usury; corruption; the private abuse of common goods; work deliberately done poorly; and waste.



**QUARESIMA 2019 Quinta Domenica:** "Donna, neppure io ti condanno; ma va e non peccare piu'". Il giudizio di Dio su di noi va oltre alla esecuzione della legge: lui vuole che ciascuno di noi ci riconosciamo peccatori, ci pentiamo e ritorniamo ad una relazione reciproca basata piu' nell'umilta' che nella presunzione di essere giusti. Con forza

dice alla donna: "Vai perdonata, ma non peccare piu'". Gli Scribi e i Farisei pure si disperdono, ma resi coscienti che anch'essi sono peccatori, bisognosi di perdono. Preghiamo: Signore, tu mi conosci nel cuore. Anch'io ho bisogno del tuo perdono.

**IL SETTIMO COMANDAMENTO: "NON RUBARE"**

**503. Che cosa enuncia il settimo Comandamento?** (2401-2402) Esso enuncia la destinazione e la distribuzione universale e la proprietà privata dei beni e il rispetto delle persone, dei loro beni e dell'integrità della creazione. La Chiesa trova fondata in questo Comandamento anche la sua dottrina sociale, che comprende il retto agire nell'attività economica e nella vita sociale e politica, il diritto e il dovere del lavoro umano, la giustizia e la solidarietà tra le nazioni, l'amore per i poveri.

**504. A quali condizioni esiste il diritto alla proprietà privata?** (2403) Il diritto alla proprietà privata esiste purché sia acquisita o ricevuta in modo giusto e purché resti primaria la destinazione universale dei beni alla soddisfazione delle necessità fondamentali di tutti gli uomini.

**505. Qual è il fine della proprietà privata?** (2404-2406) Il fine della proprietà privata è garantire la libertà e la dignità delle singole persone, aiutandole a soddisfare i bisogni fondamentali propri di coloro di cui si ha la responsabilità e anche di altri che vivono nella necessità


**506. Che cosa prescrive il settimo Comandamento?** (2407;2450-2451) Il settimo Comandamento prescrive il rispetto dei beni altrui, attraverso la pratica della giustizia e della carità, della temperanza e della solidarietà. In particolare, esige il rispetto delle promesse fatte e dei contratti stipulati; la riparazione dell'ingiustizia commessa e la restituzione del maltolto; il rispetto dell'integrità della creazione mediante l'uso prudente e moderato delle risorse minerali, vegetali e animali che sono nell'universo, con speciale attenzione verso le specie minacciate di estinzione.

**508. Che cosa proibisce il settimo Comandamento?** (2408-2413;2453-2455) Il settimo Comandamento proibisce anzitutto il furto, che è l'usurpazione del bene altrui contro la ragionevole volontà del proprietario. Ciò si verifica anche nel pagare salari ingiusti; nello speculare sul valore dei beni per trarre vantaggio a danno di altri; nel contraffare assegni o fatture. Proibisce inoltre di commettere frodi fiscali o commerciali, di arrecare volontariamente un danno alle proprietà private o pubbliche, Proibisce anche l'usura, la corruzione, l'abuso privato di beni sociali, i lavori colpevolmente male eseguiti, lo sperpero.
