A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke 10:1-12,17-20

The Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and places he himself was to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is rich but the labourers are few, so ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers to his harvest. Start off now, but remember, I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals. Salute no one on the road. 'Whatever house you go into, let your first words be, "Peace to this house!" And if a man of peace lives there, your peace will go and rest on him; if not, it will come back to you. Stay in the same house, taking what food and drink they have to offer, for the labourer deserves his wages; do not move from house to house. 'Whenever you go into a town where they make you welcome, eat what is set before you. Cure those in it who are sick, and say, "The kingdom of God is very near to you." But whenever you enter a town and they do not make you welcome, go out into its streets and say, "We wipe off the very dust of your town that clings to our feet, and leave it with you. Yet be sure of this: the kingdom of God is very near." I tell you, on that day it will not go as hard with Sodom as with that town.' The seventy-two came back rejoicing. 'Lord,' they said 'even the devils submit to us when we use your name.' He said to them, 'I watched Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Yes, I have given you power to tread underfoot serpents and scorpions and the whole strength of the enemy; nothing shall ever hurt you. Yet do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you; rejoice rather that your names are written in heaven. *The Gospel of the Lord.*

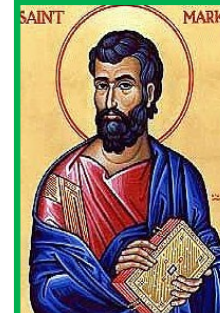

Homily notes: 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C
Return of the 72 With JOY

In sending out the 72 disciples, Jesus gives them precise instructions which express the characteristics of the mission. The first, as we have already seen, is: pray; the second: go; and then: carry no purse, no bag...; say, 'Peace be to this house' ... remain in the same house... do not go from house to house... heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you'. And if they do not receive you, go out into the streets and take your leave (cf. vv. 2-10).

These imperatives show that the mission is based on prayer; that it is itinerant: it is not idle; it is itinerant; that it requires separation and poverty; that it brings peace and healing, signs of the closeness of the Kingdom of God; that it is not proselytism but proclamation and witness; and that it also requires frankness and the evangelical freedom to leave while highlighting the responsibility of having rejected the message of salvation, but without condemnation and cursing.

If lived in these terms, the mission of the Church will be characterized by joy. And how does this passage end? The 72 "returned with joy" (cf. v. 17). It is not an ephemeral joy, which flows from the success of the mission; on the contrary, it is a joy rooted in the promise that — as Jesus says: "your names are written in heaven" (v. 20). With this expression he means inner joy, and the indestructible joy that is born out of the awareness of being called by God to follow his Son. That is, the joy of being his disciples. Today, for example, each of us, here in the Square, can think of the name we received on the day of Baptism: that name is "written in heaven", in the heart of God the Father. And it is the joy of his gift that makes a missionary of every disciple, those who walk in the company of the Lord Jesus, who learn from him to unsparingly expend themselves for others, free of oneself and of one's possessions.

Together let us invoke the maternal protection of Mary Most Holy, that she support the mission of Christ's disciples in every place; the mission to proclaim to all that God loves us, wants to save us, and calls us to join his Kingdom.

Note dell'omelia: XIV Domenica del Tempo Ordinario Anno C
Ritorno del 72 Con Gioia

Inviando i 72 discepoli, Gesù dà loro precise istruzioni che esprimono le caratteristiche della missione. Il primo, come abbiamo già visto, è: pregare; il secondo: andare; e poi: portare senza borsa, senza borsa...; dire: Pace a questa casa '... rimanere nella stessa casa... non andare di casa in casa... guarire gli ammalati in esso e dire loro, il regno di Dio è venuto vicino a voi". E se non vi ricevono, uscite per le strade e andatevene. (cfr. vv. 2-10).

Questi imperativi mostrano che la missione si basa sulla preghiera; che è itinerante: non è inattiva; è itinerante; che richiede separazione e povertà; che porta pace e guarigione, segni della vicinanza del Regno di Dio; che non è proselitismo ma annuncio e testimonianza; e che richiede anche la franchezza e la libertà evangelica di partire evidenziando la responsabilità di aver rigettato il messaggio della salvezza, ma senza condanna e maledizione.

Se vissuta in questi termini, la missione della Chiesa sarà caratterizzata dalla gioia. E come finisce questo passaggio? Il 72 "tornò con gioia" (cfr. v. 17). Non è una gioia effimera, che scaturisce dal successo della missione; è invece una gioia radicata nella promessa che - come dice Gesù: "i vostri nomi sono scritti in cielo" (v. 20). Con questa espressione si intende la gioia interiore e la gioia indistruttibile che nasce dalla consapevolezza di essere chiamati da Dio a seguire il Figlio. Cioè, la gioia di essere suoi discepoli. Oggi, per esempio, ognuno di noi, qui in Piazza, può pensare al nome che abbiamo ricevuto nel giorno del Battesimo: quel nome è "scritto in cielo", nel cuore di Dio Padre. Ed è la gioia del suo dono che fa missionario ogni discepolo, chi cammina in compagnia del Signore Gesù, chi impara da Lui a spendersi senza pietà per gli altri, liberi da se stessi e dai propri beni.

Invochiamo insieme la materna protezione di Maria Santissima, che sostiene la missione dei discepoli di Cristo in ogni luogo; la missione di annunciare a tutti che Dio ci ama, ci vuole salvare, e ci chiama ad aderire al suo Regno.


