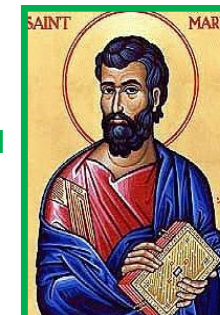

"Master, let me see again!" On this Sunday, the word of God invites us to "shout for joy" (see 1st reading from the Prophet Jeremiah) because the Lord God has promised to us a return to again celebrate in person our faith after these many months of Covid-19 lockdown, as if we have been in exile. As a community, we will gradually, be able to join in person in the Sacrifice of salvation Christ is offering for us in the celebration of the Mass (See 2nd reading from the Letter to the Hebrews). We pray that this "return" be possible and ever increasing in numbers. In this way, great rejoicing will return to the heart of all our faithful ones. It has been a long time of "sitting in blindness" as was Bartimaeus, sitting at the edge of the road, blind and sad. But, knowing the Jesus was passing by, his was filled with joyful hope and shouted: "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me! ... Master, let me see again". With the same faith and joyful hope, let us return to celebrate in person the gift of Christ salvation in the Eucharist.

A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews (5:1-6) Every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is beset with weakness. Because of this he is bound to offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not take the honour upon himself, but he is called by God, just as Aaron was. So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "Thou art my Son, today I have begotten thee"; as he says also in another place, "Thou art a priest for ever, after the order of Melchizedek." **This is the Word of the Lord.**

And they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take heart; rise, he is calling you." And throwing off his mantle he sprang up and came to Jesus. And Jesus said to him, "What do you want me to do for you?" And the blind man said to him, "Master, let me receive my sight." And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way. **The Gospel of the Lord.**

Communion Antiphon: We will ring out our joy at your saving help and exult in the name of our god.


