**A reading from the First Letter of St Paul to the Corinthians (12:3b-7,12-13)**

No one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit. Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of working, but it is the same God who inspires them all in every one. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body – Jews or Greeks, slaves or free – and all were made to drink of one Spirit. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

**Alleluia, alleluia!** Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love. **Alleluia!**

**A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St John (20:19-23)**

On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." 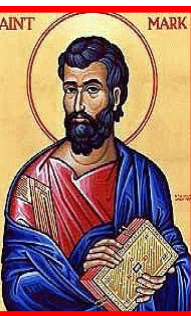

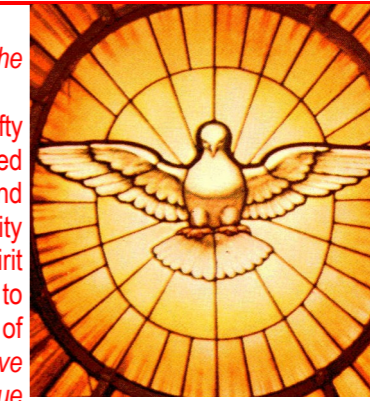
### PENTECOST SUNDAY

(48) *Serialised presentation of the Compendium of the Catechism*.

**144. What happened at Pentecost? (731-732;738)** Fifty days after the Resurrection at Pentecost the glorified Jesus Christ poured out the Spirit in abundance and revealed him as a divine Person so that the Holy Trinity was fully manifest. The mission of Christ and of the Spirit became the mission of the Church which is sent to proclaim and spread the mystery of the communion of the Holy Trinity. *"We have seen the true Light, we have received the heavenly Spirit, we have found the true faith: we adore the indivisible Trinity, who has saved us."* (Byzantine Liturgy, Troparion of Vespers of Pentecost)

**145. What does the Spirit do in the Church? (733-741;747)** The Spirit builds, animates and sanctifies the Church. As the Spirit of Love, he restores to the baptized the divine likeness that was lost through sin and causes them to live in Christ the very life of the Holy Trinity. He sends them forth to bear witness to the Truth of Christ and he organizes them in their respective functions so that all might bear "the fruit of the Spirit" (Galatians 5:22).

**146. How do Christ and his Spirit act in the hearts of the faithful? (738-741)** Christ communicates his Spirit and the grace of God through the sacraments to all the members of the Church, who thus bear the fruits of the new life of the Spirit. The Holy Spirit is also the Master of prayer.

Li manda a testimoniare la Verità di Cristo e li organizza nelle loro mutue funzioni, affinché tutti portino «il frutto dello Spirito» (Gal 5,22).

**146. Come agiscono Cristo e il suo Spirito nel cuore dei fedeli? (738-741)** Per mezzo dei sacramenti, Cristo comunica alle membra del suo Corpo il suo Spirito e la grazia di Dio che porta i frutti di *vita nuova*, secondo lo Spirito. Infine, lo Spirito Santo è il Maestro della preghiera.

**7.00 PM.: S. Messa nel 113 Aniversario della morte del Beato Giovanni Battista Scalabrini Fondatore dei Missionari Scalabriniani A servizio dei Migranti e Rifugiati.**

In Gennaio 1876, all'età di 36 anni, Giovanni Battista Scalabrini fu ordinato Vescovo di Piacenza, una delle più grandi Diocesi d'Italia, con 365 parrocchie. Durante 30 anni di episcopato egli le visitò tutte 5 volte. Durante le sue visite noto' come tanti suoi fedeli, per motivo di povertà e mancanza di lavoro, emigravano verso il Nord and Sud America o in altre nazioni d'Europa. Toccato profondamente da episodi di sfruttamento durante il processo di migrazione, desideroso di difendere la loro dignità e diritti, e mosso dalla necessità di salvaguardare la loro fede cattolica in terra straniera, confrontati da lingua sconosciuta e attornati da un ambiente protestante, egli si convinse che "qualche cosa bisognava fare" per assisterli. Alcuni gli scrissero implorando dei sacerdoti che li accompagnassero nella loro dura esperienza e offrirono il conforto della fede e dei sacramenti. Così maturo' nel suo cuore il desiderio di organizzare un gruppo di sacerdoti e suore per accompagnare i migranti.

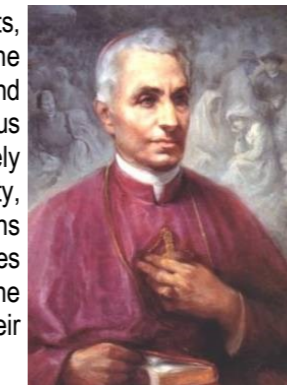

**7.00 PM.: 113<sup>th</sup> Death Anniversary Mass**

**To commemorate Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini, Founder of the Scalabrinian Congregation In Service to Migrants and Refugees.**

The Italians were leaving their country by the hundreds of thousands each year, facing many hardships and exploitation, first by the recruiters who mercilessly robbed them of their money under the pretence of assisting them. In leaving, families were ripped apart, many would innocently fall into the hands of swindlers, others were embarked to destinations not of their choice. Then the perils of the voyage across the oceans. Confronted with this painful situation causing much suffering to migrants, Scalabrini could not remain silent and he spoke fearlessly denouncing these evils and proposing social, political and religious solutions. Blessed Scalabrini actively engaged leaders in the Catholic community, the Bishops in their Diocese, the politicians in government, the Holy Father and Offices in the Vatican to take initiatives for the protection of migrants and assistance in their social, religious and moral needs.
