

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Proclaim a joyful sound and let be heard; proclaim to the ends of the earth: The Lord has freed his people, alleluia (Isa 48:20).

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (10:25-26,34-35,44-48)

When Peter entered, Cornelius met him and fell down at his feet and worshipped him. But Peter lifted him up, saying, "Stand up; I too am a man." And Peter opened his mouth and said: "Truly I perceive that God shows no partiality, but in every nation any one who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him." While Peter was still saying this, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. And the believers from among the circumcised who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles. For they heard them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter declared, "Can any one forbid water for baptizing these people who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?" And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to remain for some days. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

A reading from the First Letter of St John (4:7-10)

Beloved, let us love one another; for love is of God, and he who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God; for God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the expiation for our sins. **This is the Word of the Lord.**

Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus said, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him." Alleluia!

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St John (15:9-17)

Jesus said to his disciples, "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you; abide in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full." This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide; so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you. This I command you, to love one another.

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

DON'T STRAY FROM LOVE

John the Evangelist puts into Jesus' mouth a long farewell discourse, in which we find intensely summed up some fundamental points that his disciples need to remember throughout the coming years in order to be faithful to his person and to his project. These hold true for us today. «Remain in my love». This is number one. It's not just talking about living out a religion, but living in the love with which Jesus loves us, the love he received from the Father. Being Christian isn't mainly a doctrinal matter, but a question of love. Throughout the centuries, the disciples will know uncertainties, conflicts and all kinds of difficulties. What's important will always be not straying from love. Remaining in Jesus' love isn't something theoretical or empty of meaning. It consists in «keeping his commandments», which he himself goes on to sum up in the command of mutual love: «This is my commandment: that you love one another as I have loved you». Jesus doesn't present this command of love as a law that must rule our life, making it harder and heavier, but as a font of joy: «I have told you this so that my own joy may be in you and your joy be complete». When true love is lacking among us, it creates a vacuum that nothing or no one can fill with joy. Without love it's not possible to move forward toward a Christianity that is more open, friendly, joyful, simple and kind, where we could live as «friends» of Jesus, according to the Gospel way of talking. We won't know how to generate joy. Though we don't want to, we will keep cultivating a Christianity that is sad, full of complaints, resentments, moaning and affliction. Our Christianity frequently lacks the joy that comes from doing and living with love. Our following of Jesus lacks the enthusiasm of innovation, and we're full of the sadness that keeps coming because we don't have the conviction of reproducing what Jesus wanted of us.

NON DEVIARE DALL'AMORE L'evangelista Giovanni pone in bocca a Gesù un lungo discorso di commiato nel quale si raccolgono con una particolare intensità alcuni tratti fondamentali che i suoi discepoli devono ricordare nei tempi che seguiranno, per essere fedeli alla sua persona e al suo disegno. Anche nei nostri giorni. «Rimanete nel mio amore». È il primo tratto. Non si deve soltanto vivere in una religione, ma vivere nell'amore con il quale Gesù ci ama, l'amore che riceve dal Padre. Essere cristiano non è in primo luogo un fatto dottrinale, ma una questione di amore. Lungo i secoli, i discepoli conosceranno incertezze, conflitti e difficoltà di ogni genere. L'importante sarà sempre non deviare dall'amore. Rimanere nell'amore di Gesù non è qualcosa di teorico né senza contenuto. Consiste nell'«osservare i suoi comandamenti», che lui stesso riassume subito nel mandato dell'amore fraterno: «Questo è il mio comandamento: che vi amiate gli uni gli altri come io vi ho amato». Gesù non presenta questo mandato dell'amore come una legge che deve reggere la nostra vita facendola più dura e pesante, ma come una sorgente di gioia: «Vi dico questo perché la mia gioia sia in voi e la vostra gioia sia piena». Quando fra di noi manca il vero amore, si crea un vuoto che nulla e nessuno può riempire di gioia. Senza amore non è possibile andare verso un cristianesimo più aperto, cordiale, gioioso, semplice e amabile, in cui possiamo vivere come «amici» di Gesù, secondo l'espressione del vangelo. Non sapremo come suscitare gioia. Anche senza volerlo, continueremo a coltivare un cristianesimo triste, pieno di querele, risentimenti, lamenti e inquietudine. Al nostro cristianesimo manca, spesso, la gioia di quel che si fa e si vive con amore. Alla nostra sequela di Gesù manca l'entusiasmo dell'innovazione, e sobrabbonda la tristezza di quello che si ripete senza la convinzione di riprodurre quello che Gesù vorrebbe da noi.
