A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (1:1-11)

In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commandment through the Holy Spirit to the Apostles whom he had chosen. To them he presented himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days, and speaking of the kingdom of God. And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me, for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit." So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth." And when he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." This is the Word of the Lord.


A reading from the Letter of St Paul to the Ephesians (1:17-23)

So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. And they went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by the signs that attended it. The Gospel of the Lord.

TRUST AND RESPONSIBILITY

At some point an appendix was added to Mark's original Gospel. In it we find stated this final command of Jesus: «Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Gospel to all creation». The Gospel mustn't remain in the interior of the small group of disciples. It must go out and travel in order to reach «the whole world" and bring Good News to all peoples, to "all creation». Without a doubt, these words were heard enthusiastically when Christians were in full expansion and their communities were multiplying all across the Empire; but how to hear them today when we see ourselves powerless to retain those who are abandoning our churches because they no longer feel the need for our religion? The first thing to do is to live out an absolute trust in God's action. This is what Jesus taught us.
