HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY
“Glory to the Father, to the Son and to the Holy Spirit” Many times Jesus spoke of his Father and of the Spirit in his conversation with the Apostles. The Gospel of St. John, particularly, makes reference to Jesus being in unity with the Father and the Holy Spirit. Jesus is God, yet he speaks of himself as the Son of the Father and he is moved by the Holy Spirit in all that he does. The Spirit is the special gift he will send upon the Apostles and all those who will be baptised. His command is: “Go and baptise in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”. The three act in unity and yet they are not “qualities” of one God, but three distinct persons. The Apostles understood that God was One, yet three persons in the way of communicating with each other and with us. The preaching of the Apostles and their Letters to the communities of believers speak in the same way. This was, indeed, a clear affirmation of faith in the Holy Trinity, though a mystery to our own understanding. Our closest understanding speaks of a COMMUNITY OF LOVE. “God is Love” says St. John (1st Jn 4:16). Now, a person “in love” can only relate in love with another person, and the response of this other person make this love complete and perfect: a communion of love. This is speaking of God in human language, but it remains a mystery to our understanding: we must only believe because it was revealed to us! Jesus, however, brings this mystery closer to us when he invites us to enter into this Trinitarian Community of Love by submission and obedience to God’s will. This is our way to salvation: to enter into communion with Jesus, in obedience to God and living by his Spirit. Celebrating the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity we are affirming that our faith deals not with human ingenuity or philosophy; human intelligence and comprehension stops at the revelation of this mystery. It has, also, been revealed that God so loves us that he wants to elevate our human condition to as close he can possibly do to his divine nature. At this point, we can only marvel for what God has done for us: “to be made children of God, for so, indeed, we are”, says St. John (1st Jn 3:1). In today’s 2nd Reading, St. Paul tells the believers in Rome: “Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God... and it makes us cry out, ‘Abba, Father!’... And if we are children we are heirs of God and coheirs with Christ”. To believe in the Trinity is, also, to celebrate our intimacy in God’s love!

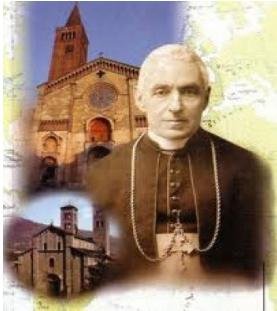


FESTA DELLA SS. TRINITÀ
“Gloria al Padre e al Figlio e allo Spirito Santo” Molte volte, conversando con gli apostoli, Gesù parlò del Padre e dello Spirito Santo. Il Vangelo di S. Giovanni, in modo particolare, parla dell’unità di Gesù con il Padre e con lo Spirito Santo. Gesù é Dio e tuttavia afferma di sé stesso come il Figlio e guidato dalla Spirito in tutta la su missione. Lui stesso promette di inviare lo Spirito Santo agli apostoli e su coloro che saranno battezzati. Il suo comando é: “Andate e battezzate nel nome del Padre e del Figlio e dello Spirito Santo”. Questi tre agiscono in unità, ma non sono una semplice “qualità”di un solo Dio, ma tre persone distinte. Gli apostoli compresero molto bene che Dio é uno ma in tre persone in relazione tra loro e nell’azione verso di noi. La predicazione degli apostolic e le loro lettere alle comunità cristiane parlano chiaramente dell’azione trinitaria di un solo Dio. Il credere nella Trinità appare chiaramente fin dagli inizi della predicazione apostolica, ma rimane per noi un mistero. Il modo più approssimativo di spiegazione é che la Trinità forma una COMUNIONE DI AMORE. “Dio é amore” dice S. Giovanni (1Gv. 4:16). Ora, una persona che ama può solo amare un’altra persona, e la risposta a questo amore fa questo amore completo e perfetto: una comunione di amore. Parliamo, certamente, con un linguaggio umano, mentre rimane un mistero alla nostra limitata intelligenza: dobbiamo solo credere perché ci é stato rivelato! Gesù porta questa misteriosa realtà vicino a noi quando ci invita a entrare in una relazione di amore con la Trinità, formando con essa una unità attraverso una sottomissione obbediente al Padre in unione con Cristo e per opera dello Spirito Santo. Questa é la nostra salvezza. Con questo noi affermiamo che la nostra fede non é una conclusione della nostra intelligenza, ma rivelazione di un mistero. Fu anche rivelato che Dio ci ama e vuole elevare la nostra condizione umana per quanto possibile più vicina alla sua natura divina. A questo punto noi possiamo solo rimanere stupiti di ciò che Dio ha fatto per noi: “Siamo stati fatti figli di Dio, e lo siamo veramente”, dice S. Giovanni (1 Gv. 3:1). Nella seconda Lettura di oggi S. Paolo dice ai fedeli di Roma: “Chi é mosso dallo Spirito é figlio di Dio... e gridiamo, ‘Abba, Papá’... E se siamo figli siamo anche eredi di Dio e co-eredi con Cristo”. Credere nella Trinità é celebrare la nostra intimità nell’amore di Dio.!
